

SWACHH BHARAT PAKHWADA-01/06/2022

Swachhta Pakhwada was Started in April 2016, with the objective of bringing a fortnight of intense focus on issues and practices of the Swachhta by engaging all the government ministries & departments in their jurisdictions. In order to plan the Pakhwada activities, an annual calendar is circulated among the Ministries in advanced. Ministries that



observe Swachhata Pakhwada are monitored by means of online monitoring system of Swachhata Samiksha. On this system, action plans, images & videos related to Swachhata activities are uploaded and shared.

Background

This is an environment awareness campaign launched under Swachh Bharat Mission. It was launched to achieve the goal of total sanitizations and cleanliness by October 2, 2019. Under the campaign, several ministries organise a theme wise campaign called "Swachh Bharat Fortnight". It is a voluntary exercise, and it seeks to raise awareness and target programmes.

Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM)

SBM is a country-wide campaign that was initiated by central government in 2014 with the objective of eliminating open defecation and improving solid waste management. This mission is a restructured version of Nirmal Bharat Abhiyan which was launched in 2009. Nirmal Bharat Abhiyan failed to achieve its intended targets. Phase 1 of the Swachh Bharat mission ended in October 2019 while Phase 2 of the mission has been implemented between 2020–21 & 2024-25.

Regarding this day 10 cadets from our unit contributed to the campaign of Swachh Bharat Pakhwada conducted on 1st June 2022 at Arthunkal beach.








ENVIRONMENTAL DAY-03/06/2022

WORLD DAY AGAINST CHILD LABOUR-12/06/2022




The World Day against Child Labor is held annually on June 12. It is an international day to raise awareness and prompt action to stop child labor in all of its forms.


READING DAY-19/06/2022

INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY-21/06/2022







NATIONAL DOCTOR'S DAY


Date - 01/07/2022

our unit's achievement.








NATIONAL YOUTH SKILL DAY






HIROSHIMA DAY

Date - 05/08/2022

Seven decades back, the world witnessed its first ever atomic bombing when the United States detonated a nuclear bomb over the Japanese city of Hiroshima, a major hub of industrial and military activities in the country. The bombing that happened around 8:15 am on August 6, 1945, killed 1.4 lakh people by the end of that year, including those who perished from radiation exposure after the blast.




The impact of the blast was such that 80,000 people died instantly while tens of thousands more lost their lives to the effects of radiation within the months and years that followed, wiping 39 per cent of the city's total population.

Hiroshima day is observed on August 6 to commemorate the atomic bombing of Hiroshima ,Japan in 1945, at the end of World War II.On August 6th, the Hiroshima day memorial service is held to commemorate the victims of the atomic bombing of Hiroshima. The service is celebrated in many countries around the world, and it is an important event in the history of Hiroshima.

NAGASAKI DAY

Japan's Nagasaki on Monday marked the 76th anniversary of the US atomic bombing. On August 9, 1945, the United States dropped the second nuclear bomb on Nagasaki, three days after Hiroshima was destroyed by the first one - a uranium bomb- 'Little Boy'.

The trophy was received from honourable minister Shri. V N Vasavan.It was indeed a prestigious moment for our unit since it was a much awaited victory sice few years.










OBITUARY








CONSTITUITION DAY-26/11/2022







- Registered candidates will receive e-certificates
- The decisions of the judges will be final and binding to all











