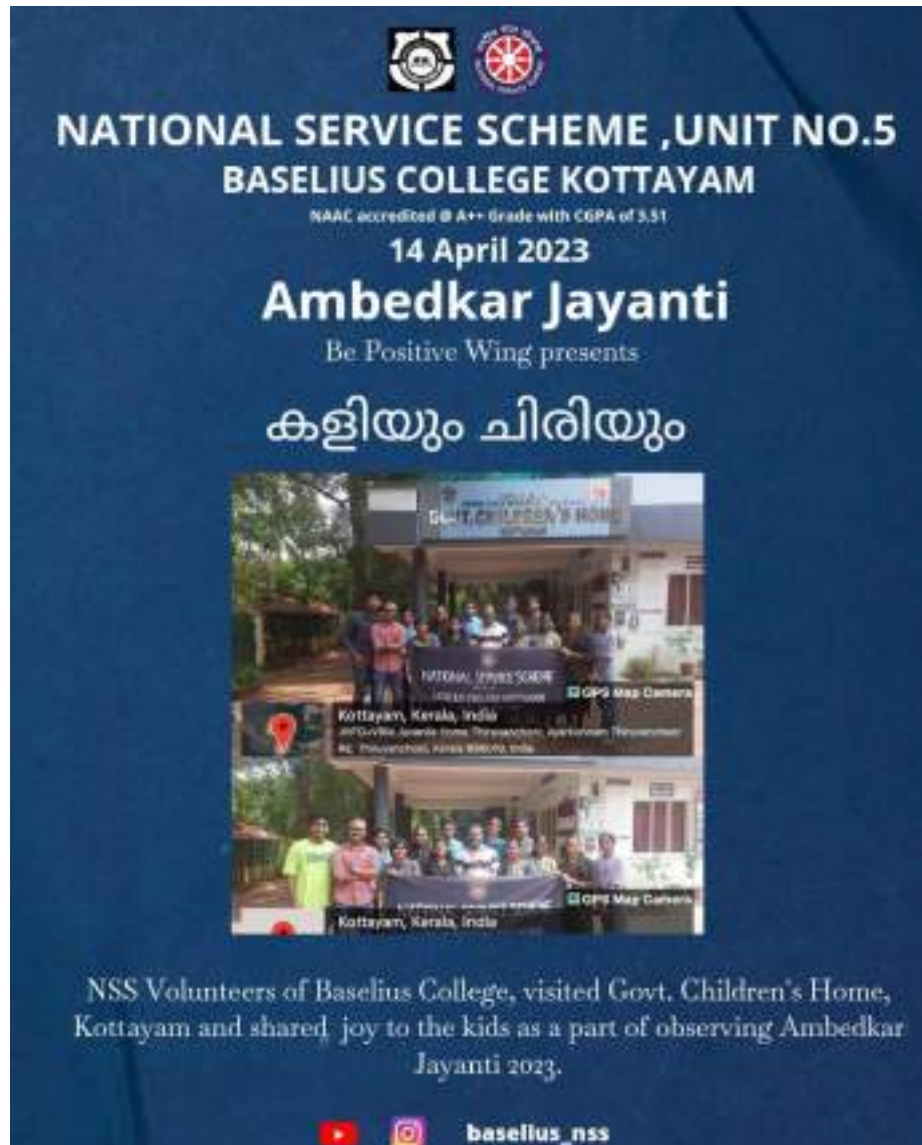



## Legal Awareness Class POSCO and other Child Related Act

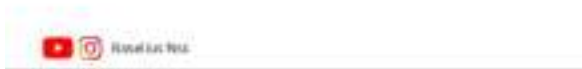

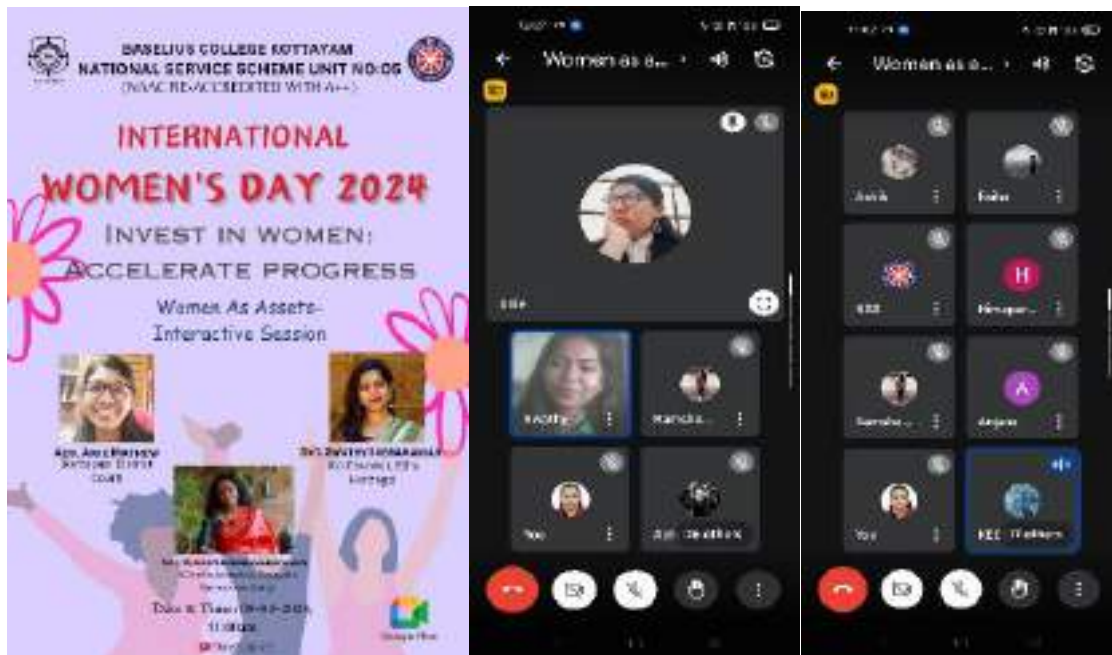




## International Women's day

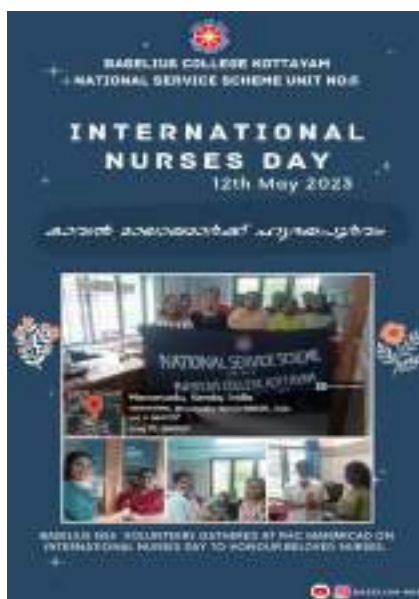

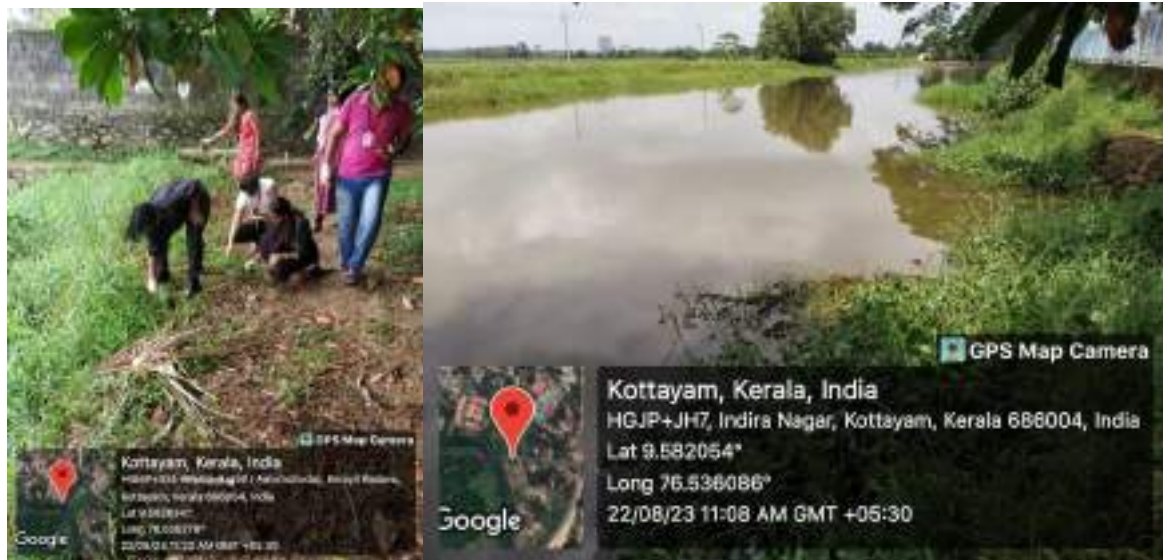

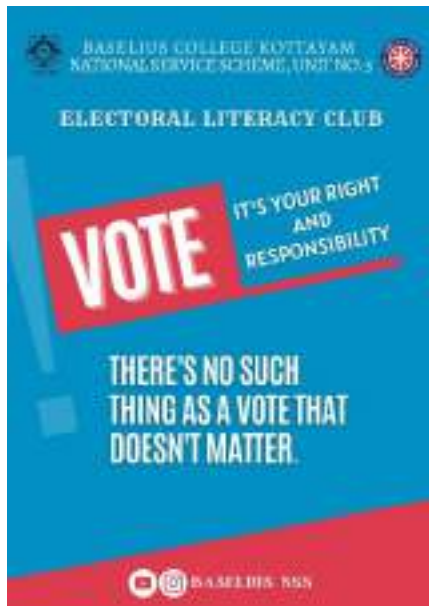
## PUTHUPALLY ELECTION BOOTH BEAUTIFICATION

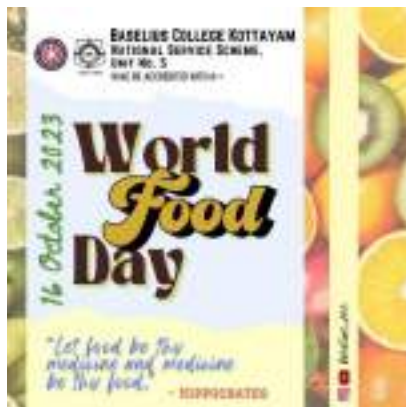


## WORLD HOSPICE & PALLIATIVE CARE DAY



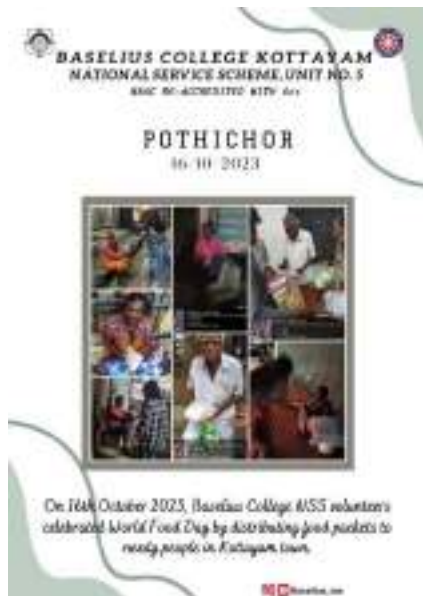

## WORLD FOOD DAY

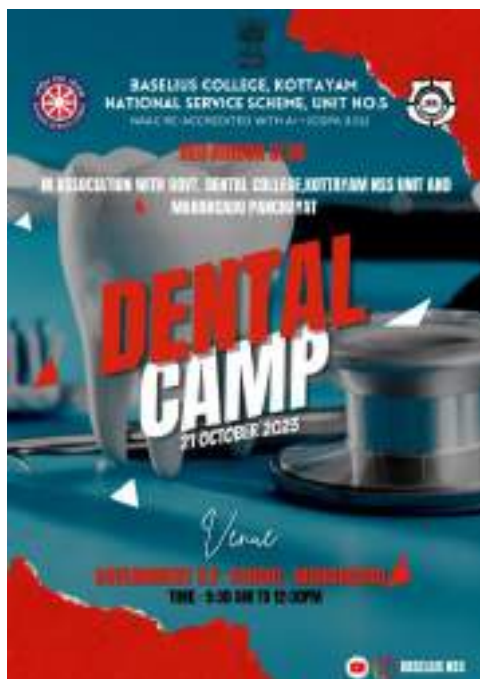

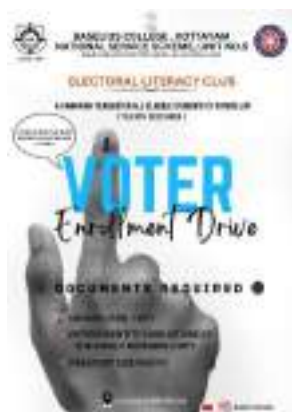

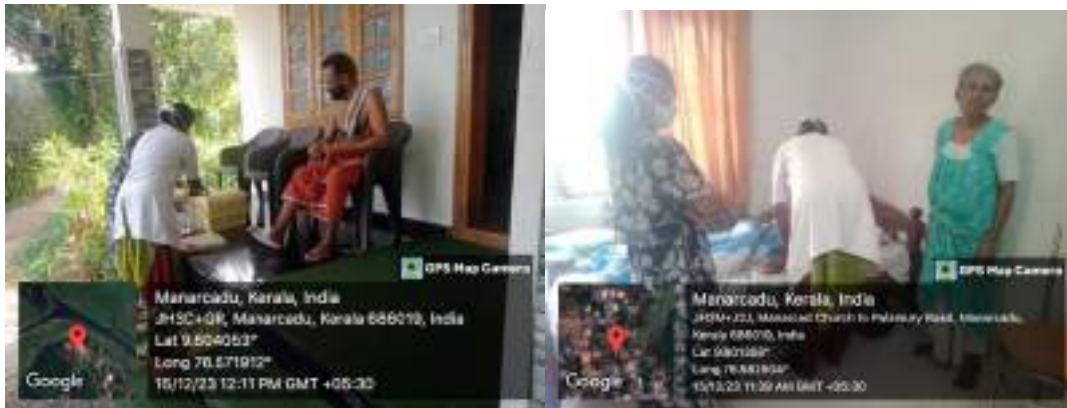




### Palliative care visit -Home Care

## TRAINING PROGRAMME ON LEADERSHIP SKILLS

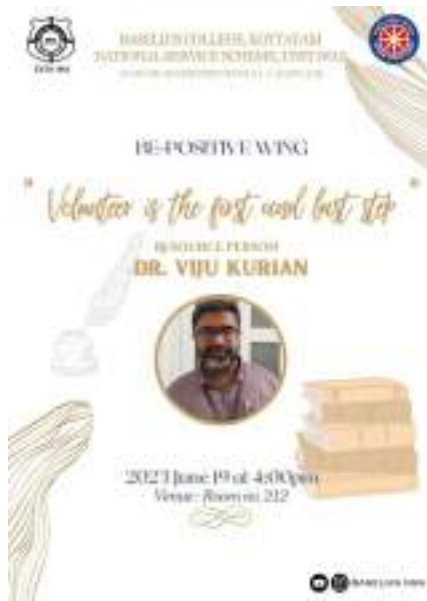
