ADMISSION TO UG / PG PROGRAMMES 2022 -23

Admission to U.G. / P.G. programmes in the colleges affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University is done through the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP). All students desirous of getting admission under any quota are required to apply online by logging in to the M.G. University website www.mgu.ac.in. Those who seek admissions under Community quota and Management quota have to submit college specific application after getting registered in the University CAP portal. They have to submit a print out of CAP registration along with the college application. Community Quota and Management Quota applications shall be available in the college office. Separate application form shall be submitted for self financing programmes.

Steps for registering online, method for arriving at your Index Mark etc. are explained in detail in the M.G. University website (www.mgu.ac.in).
