

2. Reports

A brief write-up of the above listed activities are given below

1. Inauguration of Chemistry Association: CHEMCLAVE 2022-23

The activities of the Chemistry Association, Chemclave 2022-2023 were officially inaugurated on 22nd November 2022 by Dr. Joseph T Moolayil, Associate Professor (Retd), S H College, Thevara. He is now working as a consultant for Diesel Exhaust fluids Manufacturing Company. He is a Melvin Jones fellow for the outstanding social service for the community.

The meeting began by invoking the blessings from the God Almighty. This was followed by a welcome speech from teacher in-charge of the association Dr. Jintha Thomas, who introduced the Chemistry Association ChemClave 2022-23 and spoke about its objectives. Dr.Suma Bino Thomas presided over the function. The ceremony began with the lighting of the lamp by the chief guest Dr. Joseph T Moolayil. Sreedarshana P, Association Joint Secretary, proposed vote of thanks to the gathering. Mementos were distributed to the rank holders of previous years. Anjali S (2nd Rank 2017-20) and Brinda M Nair (10th position 2017-20) received mementos.

Dr Joseph T Moolayil, delivered the keynote address on the topic "Scientific Temper and Chemistry in Everyday Life". The talk aimed to highlight the importance of developing a scientific temper in daily lives of students. The talk discussed the role of chemistry in our lives and the impact of a scientific approach to everyday problems. He emphasized that developing a scientific temper is crucial as it helps us make informed decisions and improve our understanding of the world.

The talk further highlighted the role of chemistry in our daily lives. Chemistry plays a vital role in many aspects of our lives, from the food we eat to the medicines we take. It helps us understand the materials we use and how they interact with each other. Dr. Joseph T Moolayil gave various examples of chemistry in everyday life, such as the role of chemistry in cooking, cleaning, and personal hygiene. Cleaning agents such as soap, detergents, and bleach use chemical reactions to remove dirt and stains. Personal hygiene products such as toothpaste and shampoo are also based on chemical reactions. He also gave awareness about the health hazards that can be caused by the use of non-permitted ingredients. The talk highlighted the importance of applying a scientific approach to everyday problems. Overall, the talk was informative and insightful, and it encouraged the students to develop a critical and scientific mindset in their daily lives.

2. Curies Series

Curies Series is the platform where all the members in the Department comes together periodically and have talks and discussions in different arenas of chemistry and science. Curie's series generally includes a talk delivered either by a student or teacher in the topic of their interest. This gives an opportunity to students to improve their presentation and public speaking skills. The first sessions of Curies series were organised on 28/11/2022 at 3 P M. Gauri S Nair and Bidhya Mary Biju I MSc Chemistry delivered a talk on Hydrogen energy as an alternative fuel. The next presentation was by Solliya Joseph of I MSc Chemistry on the topic Health hazards due to careless use of paracetamol.

3. World Environment Day-Awareness video on the 'Role of Green Chemistry for a Sustainable Environment

An awareness video was prepared and presented by Hena Mariam Thomas of II MSc Chemistry on World Environment Day on the topic Role of Green Chemistry for a Sustainable Environment. She discussed about Green chemistry which is a field of chemistry that focuses on developing chemical processes and products that minimize the use and generation of hazardous substances which would lower environmental impact of chemical processes and promote sustainable development. The talk emphasized the significance of green chemistry to reduce pollution, conserve natural resources, and promote the development of sustainable technologies promoting a sustainable environment.

4. Exhibition and Peace talk on Hiroshima Day Observance

An exhibition and peace talk was organized on 23rd August 2022 by the Department of Chemistry & Centre for Research together with the Postgraduate Department of Economics in collaboration with the Breakthrough Science Society, Kerala to commemorate Hiroshima Day. The exhibition showcased photographs and artifacts from the Hiroshima bombing, along with displays on the science behind the atomic bomb and its devastating impact on human lives and the environment. The exhibits were curated in a manner that helped students understand the consequences of nuclear weapons and the importance of disarmament. Faculty and Students of all the departments visited the exhibition.

A peace meeting was held on the same day at Mrs. Mammen Mappilai Hall. College Principal, Prof. Dr. Biju Thomas presided over the meeting. Association in Charge Dr. Jintha Thomas welcomed the gathering. Dr. Suma Bino Thomas, HoD of Chemistry and Dr. Shaju M J, HoD of Economics were present. The peace talk was delivered by Prof. P N Thankachan, President, Breakthrough Science Society Kerala Chapter. He talked about the dangers of nuclear weapons and the urgent need for disarmament. He discussed about the nuclear bombing and the devastation occurred in Hiroshima and Nagasaki. He also mentioned about the current global nuclear arms race and the need for international cooperation to achieve a world free from nuclear weapons.

The exhibition and peace talk were a significant success, attracting a large number of students and generating awareness about the dangers of nuclear weapons. The exhibition was particularly effective in

educating the younger generation about the importance of peace and the consequences of nuclear weapons. The displays and exhibits were designed to be engaging and informative, making it easier for visitors to understand the science behind nuclear weapons and their impact on human lives and the environment.

5. Career Guidance talk on 'Design Your Future'-Career Guidance Exclusively for Chemistry students

On 23rd February 2023, a career guidance talk titled "Design Your Future" was conducted for the chemistry students by Dr. Ajith James Jose, Assistant Professor, S. B. College Changanacherry. He is a renowned career counsellor and senate member of Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam. The programme began with a prayer song. Association in charge Dr. Jintha Thomas welcomed the gathering and Dr. Suma Bino Thomas, HoD of chemistry presided the session. All the faculty and students of the department attended the programme. Students from St.Mary's College, Manarcadu and B C M College, Kottayam also participated.

The session aimed to help the students understand various career opportunities available in the field of chemistry and how they could prepare themselves to pursue their desired career paths. Dr. Ajith James Jose emphasized the importance of identifying one's strengths and interests before choosing a career. He discussed various career opportunities available to the students, including research and development, analytical chemistry, pharmaceuticals, biotechnology, forensic science etc. The speaker then delved into each of these fields, discussing the job roles, required qualifications, and skills necessary to excel in them. He also highlighted the current market trends and the demand for skilled professionals in each of these fields. The speaker then talked about the importance of networking and building a professional network, especially in the field of chemistry, where collaboration is vital for success. He emphasized the need to gain practical experience through internships and research projects, which can help the students to build their skills and increase their chances of getting hired.

The session was very successful and many students expressed their gratitude and gave positive feedback about the session. Solliya Joseph of I MSc chemistry proposed vote of thanks.
