







Summary of Report : Add On Course on Creative Writing For III B.A English Students

(2021-22)

The primary objective of the course was to inculcate in students a genuine interest in the

creative aspect of language, encourage new thinking and generate a hands-on experience in

handling language for various purposes. The course had been crafted with the aim of

rekindling the creative spark in the students and thereby develop fresh insights into the

practice and reception of writing as an art form.

The course was split into 5 modules to span 30 hours (20 hours contact classes and 10 hours

practicals). On 4/1 Dr. Vidya Merlin Varghese and Dr. Kavitha Gopalakrishnan gave an

introduction to the course to familiarise them with what to expect from the course. The course

was tailormade to cover the following modules:

MODULE I- Creative Writing1: Nuances of Prose and Poetry

MODULE II- Creative Writing 2: Translation

MODULE III- Creative Writing 3: Theatre and Film

MODULE IV- Creative Writing 4: Technical Writing

MODULE V – Creative Writing 5: Hands on Experience

Dr. Nibulal Vetoor, Assistant Professor at Department of Malayalam, Baselius College handled writing prose in 5/1/2021 and shared his experiences as a creative writer. On 6/1/2022, Dr. Vidya Merlin Varghese, Assistant Professor at Department of English, Baselius College gave a detailed introduction to Creative Writing. On 7/1/22, Dr Prasara, Assistant Professor at Department of Hindi, Baselius College conducted a class on translation. On 16/2/22, Dr. Kavitha Gopalakrishnan, Assistant Professor at Department of English, Baselius College took a class on Review writing. Mr. Jithin John, Assistant Professor at Department of English, Baselius College, took a class on theatre on 17/2/22. On 18/2/22, Dr Anju Sosan George, Assistant Professor at Department of English, CMS College, conducted a session on Poetry Writing. Mr. Gokul M Nair, Assistant Professor of Rajagiri College, conducted class on Documentary writing on 19/2/22. In the Midhula Mariam Jeevan, took a class on Content Writing. On 21/2/22, Dr. Jyothimol P, reputed translator, author and Vice Principal of the College took a class on Translation. On 26/2/22, Mr. Ajesh Raju, took a class over Gmeet on Copyediting in advertising and marketing. On 26/2/2022, Mr. Dileep M.K spoke on Writing for Radio. On 27/2, Mr. Ditto, Assistant Professor at Department of English, CMS College, took class on theatre, blogging. On 5 / 3/2022, Ms. Sruthy Ullas, took a class on Writing for print media.

After Hands on Session, students submitted their creative outpourings and the coordinators compiled the same. On 11/4/2022, a test was conducted and score was compiled.

SYLLABUS:

COURSE TITLE: CREATIVE WRITING

TOTAL HOURS: 30

Aims and Objective: The primary objective of the course is to inculcate in students a genuine interest in the creative aspect of language. The course will encourage new thinking, observation skills, editing basics and will alongside generate a hands on experience in handling language for various purposes. The course has been crafted with the aim of rekindling the creative spark in the students and thereby develop fresh insights into the practice and reception of writing as an art form.

Course Description: The course is split into 5 modules (20 hours contact classes and 10 hours practicals). Each module offers elementary information on the basics of creative writing as a discipline in itself and ranges across different spheres. The learning outcome of the course can be analysed on the basis of the project work submitted by the students. The practical sessions will also encourage group thinking and individual creativity.

COURSE OUTLINE

MODULE I- Creative Writing1: Nuances of Prose and Poetry (5 Hours)

Introduction to Creative writing- word power -writing and reading as interdependent activities-primary methods on how to write a story-originality- creativity/aestheticity-how to write a poem-introduction to tools of poetry- review writing — creative writing versus academic writing.

MODULE II- Creative Writing 2: Translation

(5Hours)

Definition of Translation –window to other cultures-source language- target language-types of translation-familiarising regional language translations- scope and significance of translation-opportunities for translators

MODULE III- Creative Writing 3: Theatre and Film

Theatre introduction- theatre and women- women performers in India- reel writing- script writing-theatre as a collaborative art form – documentary writing

MODULE IV- Creative Writing 4: Technical Writing (5 Hours)

Content writing-blog writing- types of content- keyword research and SEO- scope and reach of content writing- COPY EDITING basics- style guides used for editing- writing for newspaper- media writing basics- radio podcast writing- technical writing introduction-

MODULE V – Creative Writing 5: Hands on Experience

Based on the basics gathered from the previous modules students are given an opportunity to practice what they imbibed- focus on product is made possible by encouraging each of them to select any module of their choice and submit the assignment at the end of the session.

REPORT OF FESTIVELITA 2K22

The pandemic situation made it practically impossible for the Postgraduate Department of English and Centre for Research,

Baselius College, to conduct the intercollegiate Quiz and Elocution competition in an offline mode. The pending edition (42nd edition) of the Intercollegiate Quiz and Elocution Competition (FESTIVELITA 2K22), was held in the online mode on 17th June,2022 and 16th June,2022 respectively. The smooth conduct of the events was made possible through the wholehearted support and coordination skills of the student coordinators. The teacher in charge Dr Vidya Merlin Varghese convened a quick meeting and a




