
WORLD LIVER DAY

JIVAMUKTI






SUSTAINABLE MENSTRUAL CARE INITIATIVE

Through this session all the students become aware of the importance of menstrual hygiene.






WEBINAR-CAN I DONATE BLOOD?

QUIZ COMPETITION









INTERNATIONAL DAY AGAINST DRUG ABUSE AND ILLICIT TRAFFICKING - POSTER MAKING COMPETITION

Then we have conducted interdepartmental poster making competition. We had a good number of competitors among every department.






STAGE CRISIS MANAGEMENT

WEBINAR- HEPATITIS FREE FUTURE





WEBINAR: HOW TO PREVENT MONKEY POX








AUGUST 06 HIROSHIMA DAY











October 10 World mental health Day

O 'clock. At 9:30 the day ended with camp analysis and interfaith prayer.


Camp report – 7th day









ROAD SAFETY AWARENESS









NATIONAL VOTER'S DAY








74TH REPUBLIC DAY (സ്ഥാതന്ത്ര്യ ദിനം)










FEBRUARY 14, 2023 TRIBUTE TO MARTYR'S OF PULWAMA ATTACK




FEBRUARY 15, 2023 INTERNATIONAL CHILDHOOD CANCER DAY






INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY






INTERNATIONAL DAY OF ACTION FOR RIVER






WORLD WATER DAY
