Onam Celebrations

Onam celebrations are always a matter of joy and pride as far as Basilians are concerned. This year too, there was a flamboyant campus with a real festive mood. The Arts club organized some competitions in connection with Onam- those which remind us of the traditions and the cultural value. Though the programmes were organised on a competitive basis, the ultimate aim was to invoke a feeling of the broad secular Malayalee spirit. Thus, Pookalam Competition, Onam Song Competition and Kerala Sriman/ Shalini Competition were conducted on 21st August 2015, Friday. An elocution competition with the theme “Importance of handloom fabrics’ was also organized.. The criteria and the guidelines for the competitions were conveyed to the Subject Associations sufficiently earlier. Prior registration of the events were done. The Department of Industries, Kottayam sponsored prizes for the elocution competition and Kerala Sreeman/Salini competitions

The judging panel of Kerala Sriman and Shalini consisted of **Dr Jancey Thomas** and Dr Jyothimol P and was co-ordinated by Prof Jyothi Susan Abraham and Prof Nibu B Thomas

The title of Kerala Sreeman was bestowed upon Ajaikrishnan of Department of English. Tony Antony of the Department of Chemistry and Akash Francis of the Department of Physics were the 1st and 2nd runner-up respectively. The title ‘Kerala Shalini’ was bestowed upon P K Archana of the Department of Commerce. The 1st runner-up was Aswathy Anilkumar of the Department of Zoology and Mrinalini Susan George of Department of English as well as Easwari P of the Department of Chemistry.

‘Onapattu’ competition was judged by Ms Binimol C K, Prof. Vidya Merlin Varghese and Ms Aswathi Chandran. The Department of Commerce bagged the 1st Prize, Department of Vocational Commerce 2nd; the third was bagged by Department of Chemistry.

‘Pookalam’ competition was judged by Prof. Bejoy D Abraham, Dr. Thomson Roby, Suma Bino Thomas and Ms Mishel Elizabeth . Department of English secured the 1st place, followed by Zoology and Economics Departments. Cash awards of Rs 4500 were sponsored by DIC.
