#### **Onam Celebrations**

The Arts club organized some competitions in connection with Onam- those which remind us of the traditions and the cultural value. Though the programmes were organsied on a competitive basis, the ultimate aim was to invoke a feeling of the broad secular Malayalee spirit. Thus, AthaPookalam Competition, and Onam Song Competition were conducted on 7<sup>th</sup> August 2016. The criteria and the guidelines for the competitions were conveyed to the subject associations sufficiently earlier. Prior registration of the events was done.

The judging panel of Atthapookalam competition and Onam song competition consisted of Smt.
