In the academic year of 2014- 15, the Literary Club of Baselius College took pride in the literary achievements of its students. Our students went to various colleges and institutions and participated in competitions. They bagged many prizes and made their college proud.

- Pulintharakunnel P. C. George Memorial **Essay Competition** organised by Mochana De- Addiction and Counselling Centre (31 August 2014)

Topic- ‘A Liquor free Kerala- My dream’. Twenty seven students of various departments forwarded their essays.
