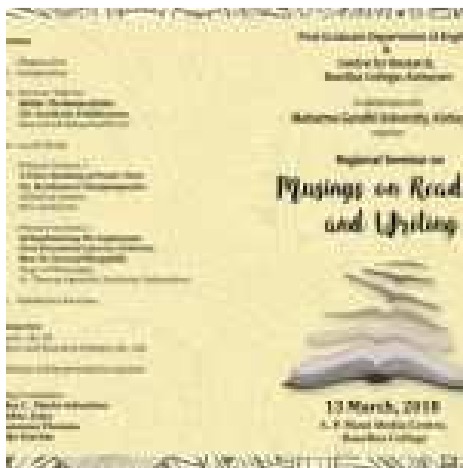

Baselius College, Kottayam has been blessed with the presence of a great teacher from the time of its inception in 1954. Menon had a great impact on the lives of his students and the progress of Baselius has gone on in the footsteps of their inspirational teachers and several of them who come in contact with them. **Prof. P. Rajaram Menon** was the teacher among these renowned academics.

There was the famous Fortnightly Series on Educational Studies August 1957 in the name of Dr. Rajaram Menon, Professor and Head, Kuravillogai, and Department of Education, Government of Madhya Pradesh, India. Baselius has started a Cultural Centre, Kottayam in 1985. Every year, Baselius sends a team to Baselius College, Kerala for being a student. As has been the case, Baselius has made its valuable contributions to the Department in the initial years of its commencement and it is wished to go forward in the footsteps of the founder. A tradition of learning, leadership and research has been established and continuing by each knowledge, progressive activities and events, Baselius through.

Prof. P. Rajaram Menon passed away on the 17th July 2001. The Dept. of English has been organizing a memorial lecture every year, in honour of the great teacher. Dr. Sukanya Acharyan (2008), Dr. N.S. Radhakrishnan (2009), Dr. Antony James (2010), Dr. Shibu Paul (2011), Dr. P.P. Srinivasan (2012), Dr. Shyju James (2013), Dr. C. Gopinathan (2014) and Prof. Sampath Das (2015) have all delivered their respective memorial lectures. Last year, Dr. S. Unnikrishnan, renowned film director, delivered his lecture on "The Politics of Language".

Unni R., an alumnus of Baselius College, is a well-known name in the short story world. He has been published in Kottayam, though he is currently settled in Thiruvananthapuram. Some of his short stories have been republished in various journals, including Keralakalasham, Kalyanam 17 and Laxmi. His stories being adapted into a film by Baselius. He has also been awarded the Kerala State Film Award for Best Screenplay for the movie "Cherry in 2015". Interestingly, the movie just like the adaptation of his story "A Walk with a Woman" from the film "A Walk with a Woman". His stories have been translated into other Indian languages including Tamil where his stories were appreciated by such accomplished writers like P. Madhav Prasad. Unni R. has also written some non-fictional material.

Prof. Jacob Kurian Onattu, currently Principal of Margaret College in Arakkal, Kottayam, formerly principal of Baselius College, Kottayam and K.S.L. College, Pattanam had been an illustrious and distinguished member of the Dept. of English for more than three decades. The silver jubilee of the M.D. Management, Prof. Onattu has joined his efforts as an exemplary teacher, an excellent administrator and a remarkable colleague in his teaching career.
