

PROF. M C JACOB

The illustrious and eminent professor, M C Jacob took the helm of department in 1969. Under his stewardship the department was hailed as one of the best Commerce Departments in the erstwhile Kerala University. The milestones of this department often coincided with that of the college itself. It is with the launch of M.Com programme in the Department, in 1981 that the college was elevated to the level of first grade College.

Professor M C Jacob was born on the 23rd of September 1932 as the son of Late Sri M.M.Chandy and Late Smt. Susamma Chandy. He did his schooling from CMS College High School and completed his graduation from S.D. College Alappuzha. He obtained his Post Graduation from the Dept. of Commerce, Banaras Hindu University and started his career as a lecturer in the Department of Commerce, Fathima Matha College, Kollam and later on served as a faculty of Dept. of Commerce, S.D. College Alappuzha. Our Department of Commerce had been fortunate to have his eminent and motivating presence from 1967 to 1988.



SANTHOSH GEORGE KULANGARA is the founder and chief explorer of Safari TV, the first and only exploration channel in India. He started his career in television media at the age of 17 and recognized well with production of a number of tele films, tele serials and documentaries for Doordarshan, Thiruvananthapuram. His most important contribution to the visual media is Sancharam - the first visual travelogue in Malayalam. He has already completed his journey to more than 100 countries in Asian, African, Australian, American, European continents and Antarctica during last 19 years. After 16 years since he had started travelling. Sancharam has turned out to be an exclusive, round theclock exploration channel Safari. Santhosh George Kulangara has written six books related to his travels and experiences around the world. He won the Kerala Sahithya Accademi Award for the travelogue Baltic Diary (2014), Rapa National Award for the director of the best non-fiction TV programme (2003), The Kamal Patra award of Junior Chamber International for young businessmen (2002), Akshaya' National Award (2003), Film Critics Association Award (2003, 2006), National Film Academy Award (2005), The Rapa National Award for the best director (2003, 2004), Rotary Star of The Year Award (2007), The Outstanding Young Indian Award of Indian Junior Chamber. (2005, 2010), Vivekananda Puraskaram (2007), Chancellor live mini screen award, K R Narayanan media award (2007), Youth Hostels Association award (2007), Asian Television award (2009). Sancharam has entered into the Limca Book of Records for being a visual travelogue prepared by a person travelling solo to various nations (2007).



FR. MATHAI OIC is an alumnus of the Department of Commerce, Baselius College Kottayam. He did his Pre-degree and B. Com during the year 1970-75. He secured his BD from Orthodox Theological College, Kottayam, B. Ed from Jabalpur and Diploma in Law from Annamalai University, Tamil Nadu. He served as a Principal for 23 years in Bethany St. John's English Higher Secondary School, Kunnamkulam, Manager of Bethany Asram and has been the superior of Bethany Asram twice. At present, he is the secretary of Bethany Asram and patron of Chaithanya Special school Kunnamkulam and Sukarma pain and palliative charity society, Ranni, Perunadu.
