
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



#### Poverty Line across prevailing caste sections






Percentage of Individuals



Irrigated area and unirrigated area of total cultivable area





### Average Productivity per acre(in quintals) of major crops






#### **Occupation Pattern**









Total Electric Load of common village facilities : 2.35(kW)




#### Cooking Fuels Usage in Village
