**2.2.2. Onam Celebration on 02-09-2022**

After a gap of two years, Onam celebrations were back with its pomp and glory with added enthusiasm. The day started with a mega thiruvathira by students held at the college quadrangle. So the Arts club decided to conduct a Kerala Sreeman and Kerala Salini contest for the students. **2.2.3. Essay Competition - Literary Club in association with Sree Sathya Sai Seva Sanghadana on 11-10-2022**

An essay writing competition was organized under the auspices of the College Literary Club in collaboration with Sri Sathya Sai Seva Organization. 12 students from various departments participated in the essay competition organized on the topic "Education is not for Living but for Life". The competition was organized on 13/10/2022 from 3.00 pm to 4.30 pm at the Malayalam department library.

**2.2. 4. Power Quiz 2022 - Quiz Club in association with KSEB on 20-10-2022**

Interactive quiz organized by KSEB. The power quiz is being conducted among the students with the aim to spread awareness about energy sector and were organized with enthusiastic participation in the previous years. This year power quiz was conducted on 20 October 2022.

The preliminary level of this All-Kerala Quiz Competition was conducted in our college at 1:10-2:10 in Room 212. Around 40 students participated from all the departments. The questions was multiple choice, the highest among them was Abhijit Jose of Final year Mathematics and Akhil K M of Second Msc physics and they were eligible for district level. As the results were declared KSEB officers handed over the certificates.

**2.2.5. Bodha Poornima Classroom Debates - Organised by Debate Club in association with Economics Department on 28-10-2022**

A classroom debate was organized online in connection with Bodha Poornima campaign of Government of Kerala. The programme was held online on 28.10.22. First and second year post graduate economics students were selected for the classroom debate. The topic of the debate was “Are existing interventions to curb substance abuse effective or not?”. Students spoke both for and against the motion. Those who spoke for the motion pointed out that due to initiatives aimed at mitigating substance abuse (like vimukthi), the vigilance and awareness of society in general increased. They opined that these campaigns should focus more on school children as the message is likely to be deeply engraved in their minds forever. Awareness, guidance and counselling can bring back a vast majority of those are inclined into substance abuse.

Those who spoke against the motion were not fully against anti-substance abuse campaigns. But they pointed out that some aspects require attention. Ultimately, the decision to refrain from substance abuse is to be taken by the individuals concerned. This aspect is particularly significant among adolescent and youth where peer pressure and curiosity can play a dangerous role. The availability of narcotic and psychotropic substances should decline. This supply side is as important as reducing their abuse through campaigns. The rising cases of substance abuse is a testimony of ineffectiveness of such campaigns. Despite government efforts the roots of supply chains of psychotropic substances cannot be traced completely. Students also pointed at misuse of social media to promote substance abuse. Severe addicts cannot be transformed by mere awareness campaigns. General reluctance of youth to heed top advice also play a role here.

### RULES FOR DEBATE COMPETITION

- 1) A team consists of two members, one of whom will talk in favour of the subject and other against it.
- 2) Each participant will be given 5 (five) minutes to present his/her views.
- 3) After the stipulated 10 (ten) minutes allotted for a team, an additional 3 (three) minutes will also be given for questions by the moderator/audience to one of the speakers, and the answer should be given by that speaker himself/herself.
- 4) The moderator may ask the other debater in the team to present his/her argument on what the first speaker has stated.
- 5) Whenever one participant of a team answers a question, the other member of the team has to state his opinion, whether he agrees with his team member or not. If not, he has to explain his version, against which the other team member can again give his/her clarification. Thus, the argument should go in a weaving manner between each other, and the maximum time allotted is 4 (four) minutes.
- 6) After deliverance by a team (5+5 minutes each) and the additional 4 (four) minutes (maximum) given to a team, the judges will be asked to evaluate the team. After evaluation by the judges, the time manager will call the next team.
- 7) Each debate will begin with a bell and a warning bell will sound after 3 (three) minutes, informing team members that the time allotted to him/her is over. Afterwards, in the same manner, another bell will be rung to announce the commencement of a 3 (three) minutes argument on the question raised by the moderator/audience, to a team member.
- 8) No team shall disclose their identity, other than their chest numbers.
- 9) Points noted in a paper or on a laptop could be used, but reading from books/notes, laptops etc are not permitted.
- 10) If a team member, the moderator, or anyone else interrupts the debate without fault on the part of the debater, the time taken away is extended as per the stipulated time.
- 11) The participants are requested to be focused on the subject with a systematic, point by point delivery for or against the theme.
- 12) During the 4 (four) minute argument, none of the participants shall ask any questions.
- 13) After completion of the talk by all the teams in the above manner, a maximum of 30 (thirty) minutes free argument/clarification session will be held. This will be against the questions/arguments raised by the audience or any other participants. The person who raises the question must pin point the team member from whom he wants to get a clarification. However, the number of questions to be asked by the audience/judges/moderator to a team is restricted to one and all teams would get an opportunity.
- 14) The clarifications given by the team member in the 30 (thirty) minutes time mentioned, will also be considered for awarding additional marks.
- 15) Audience shall not intentionally or continuously question one participant. The answers given by a team member shall be countered or agreed upon by the other team member.
