Onam Celebrations

The Arts club organized some competitions in connection with Onam- those which remind us of the traditions and the cultural value. Though the programmes were organised on a competitive basis, the ultimate aim was to invoke a feeling of the broad secular Malayalee spirit. Thus, Athapookalam Competition, and Onam Song Competition were conducted on 7th August 2016. . The criteria and the guidelines for the competitions were conveyed to the subject associations sufficiently earlier. Prior registration of the events was done.

The judging panel of Athapookalam competition and Onam song competition consisted of Smt. Seena R Nair (UGC-Librarian), Prof. Jithin John (Assistant Professor of English), Ms. Arathy A.
