FRIENDLY FOOTBALL MATCH - DRUGS FREE VILLAGE INITIATIVE: 9th September, 2019

An Anti-Drugs initiative after understanding the influence of drugs among the young of our adopted village Arpookara. The call for revival when the spirit of sports was blended against the spirit towards drugs when one of the team was represented by volunteers and the other was the youngsters of Arpoorkara .The volunteers also played a flash mob in the break time.



SOCIO-ECONOMIC SURVEY

Volunteer groups accompanied by Asha workers and senior volunteers conducted a survey at Arpookkara, Athirampuzha and Vijayapuram. The details regarding the Socio-Economic aspects of village as well as the problems faced by the villagers in relation to waste management was understood in detail and possible solutions were suggested. The survey data was uploaded into the UBA portal and analysis was generated.

PLASTIC BOTTLE CHALLENGE AND REUSE: LITTER FREE VILLAGE 10th September,2019

A plastic free village initiative where the UBA volunteers collected plastic bottle from the village household and gifted the same back after converting it into usable garden pots with plants

DRAINAGE CLEANING - 10th September 2019

In order to make the village Litter Free and Flood Free a drainage that was in a disgusting state with plastic covers and other wastes was cleaned by the volunteers. Rebirth was given to the Drainage for water to flow freely during heavy rain and enthusiastic volunteers together with active villagers helped to clean over 300 meter of cana.

SURAKSHA-LIFE SKILL TRAINING

A Self defence training was arranged or the ladies of the village and basic defence techniques were taught to safeguard themselves and to help others in need. The session was led by qualified instructors

VEETIL ORU MARAM - 7th September, 2019

Veetil oru maram is our dream project in Arpookara were a sapling was planted in each house by the volunteers themselves. It was a contribution towards the future. 'Veetil oru karivepp' was an added project to this.

HERBAL GARDEN - 8th September, 2019

A herbal garden was created at Govt. High School Karipputhattu, Arpookkara, with the aim of popularizing the usefulness and need to conserve the locally available medicinal plants with name tags hung aside the sapling

SRAMADAN: 12th September, 2019

Volunteers were divided into groups and cleaned the Arpookkara school courtyard and the surroundings rending a green and clean message.
