Program Specific outcomes	<p>The programme prepares students to become informed active citizens. Undergraduate and graduate programs emphasize the comprehension of political thinking, the application of communication and analytical skills, and the understanding of cultural diversity .The programme also enables acquisition of citizenship skills, ethical values, and the ability to understand and appreciate human diversity; and to engage in community life as active citizens. As each topic is to be studied with reference to concepts, theories, students acquire research skills thereby develop a systematic understanding about political phenomena and learn to deal with development issues and to solve social problems. While institutions are often studied as parts of the state apparatus, this course hopes to place them within the shared common space of democracy, which is created by the exchanges and interactions among institutions.</p>
