FEEDBACK BY P G STUDENTS

The first-year postgraduate students were asked to provide feedback on the various aspects related to their curriculum, mode of teaching-learning-evaluation, other enrichment activities etc. They were asked to provide a critical review so that improvements can be made in these aspects. The questions were rated in a 5-point scale. Based on responses from 99 students, the following scores are available:

The students expressed average to above average satisfaction on most of the aspects. However, the level of satisfaction on the overall academic orientation and scope for timely completion of portion was comparatively lower. The late commencement of classes and no availability of adequate days in a semester were pointed out as an issue. The students were also found to have lower level of satisfaction on the orientation for NET examinations.

Action Taken

- ✓ The PG departments were asked to conduct more academic lectures and orientation programmes.
- ✓ NET training could be offered for first year students too.
- ✓ In spite of late start, proper scheduling of Internal Examinations would be helpful for the students to have an idea regarding how to approach the examinations. Departments prepared their academic schedule based on the Institution's annual academic plan and adhered to the plans.
