Report 2019-20



The activities of the club were mainly aimed at creating ample opportunities and training to the budding singing talents of our college. This year the club started its activity on Sep 20th 2019 with an initial meeting of all the members of the club. From the meeting, Jinesh Joseph Varghese of D3 Zoology was selected as the student coordinator. The main activities of the club can be summarised as

- Organised singing talent hunt- "Voice of Baselius"
- Organised various musical events for the college arts festival.
- Training was given to selected students to participate in the MG University Kalolsavam-Article 14.
- Organised various programs during the Covid-19 pandemic lockdown period



Voice of Baselius

Music club decided to conduct a singing talent hunt, "Voice of Baselius" to provide a platform for the music lovers of the college to showcase their talent as well as to find the best singer of the college. The competition was conducted in 4 rounds. First-round was an online round. The participants were asked to upload a song Club of their choice to the official WhatsApp group of the Music and 44 students from various departments participated.
