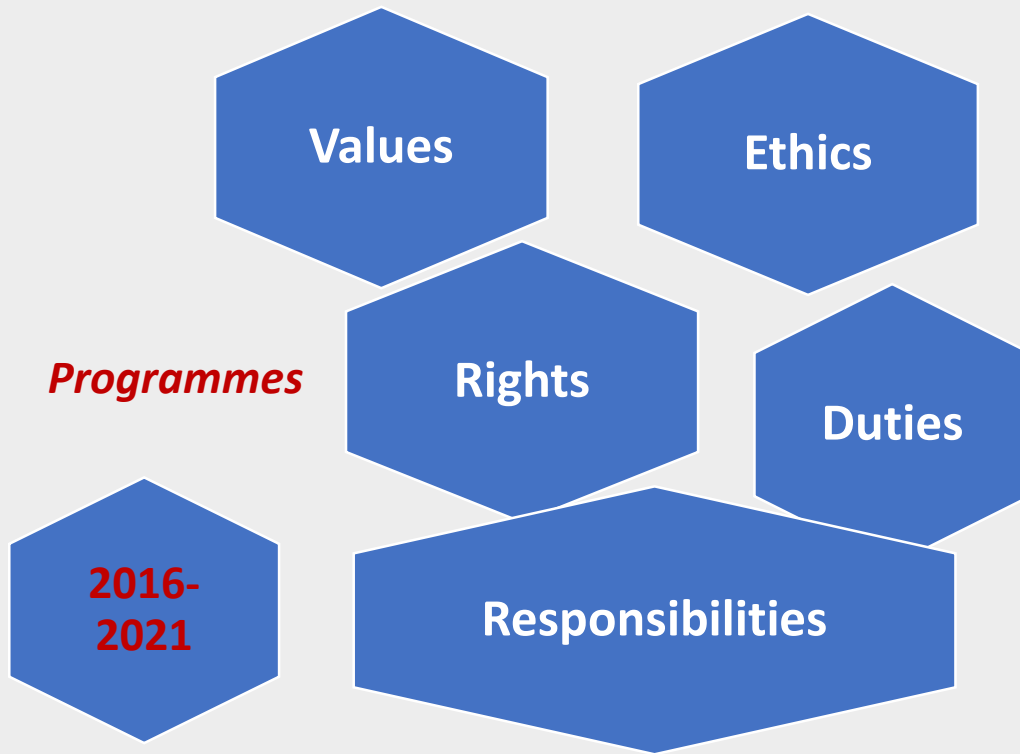

### **3. VOTER'S ID REGISTRATION- HOW TO DO?**

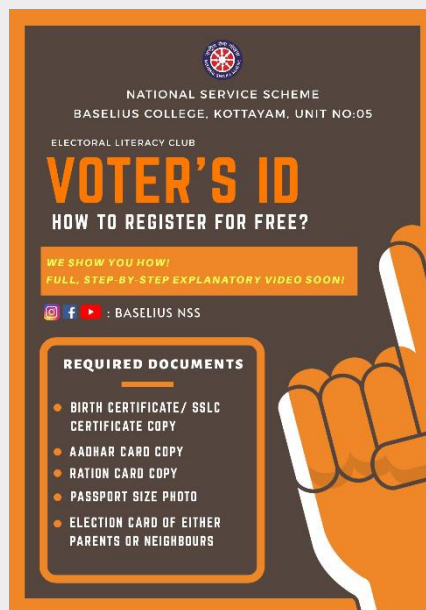
