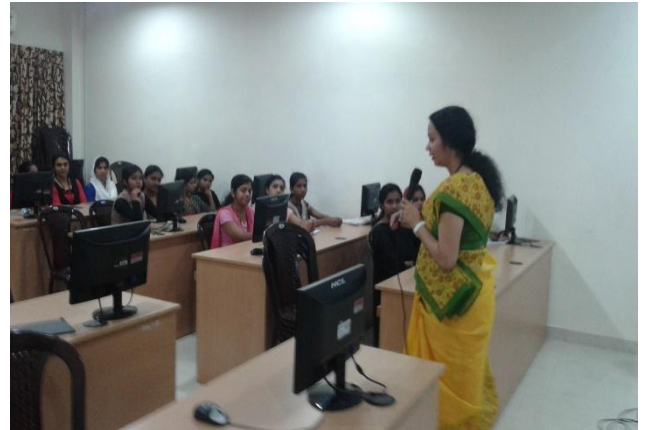
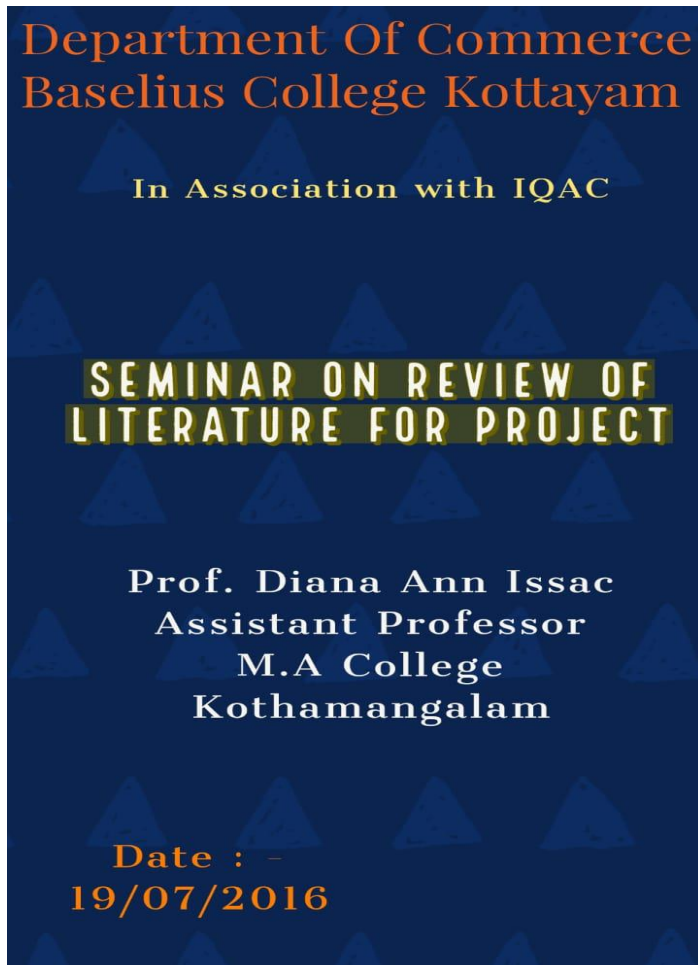

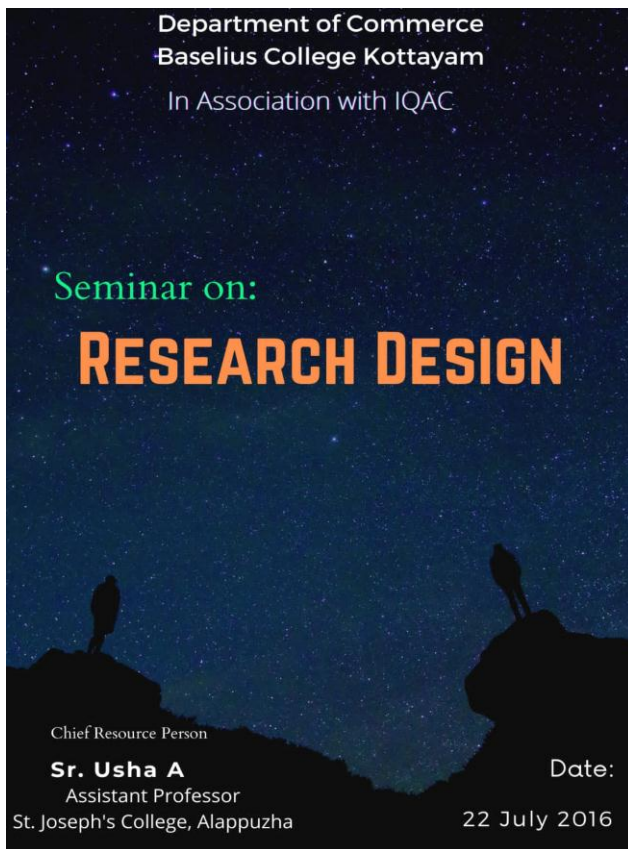
1. Seminar: Review of Literature for Projects

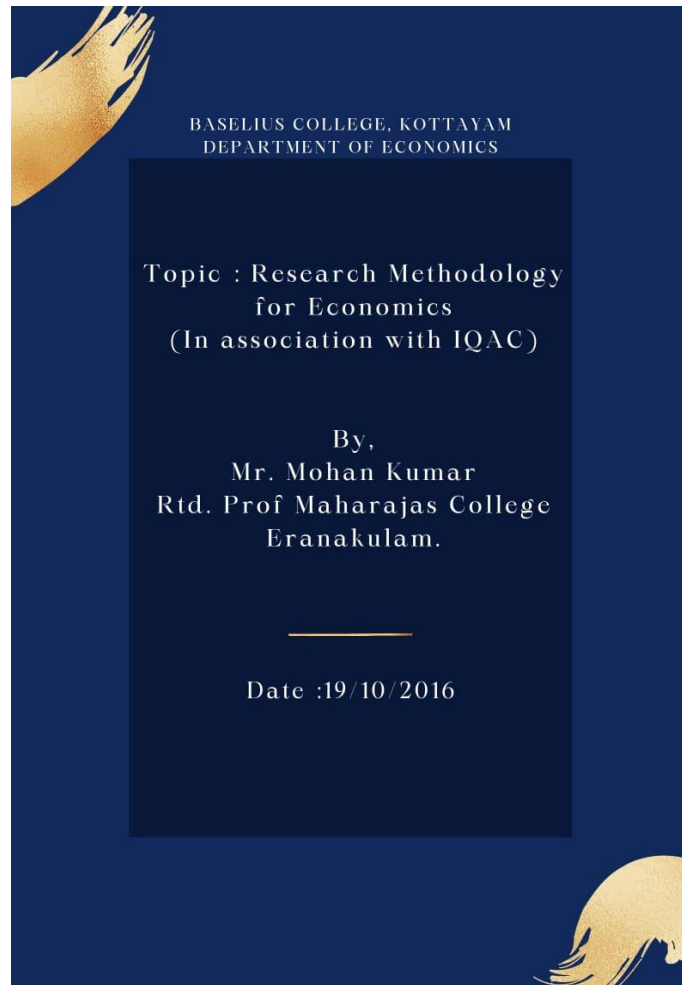
5. Workshop: “Experimental Chemistry - Macro to Micro level”

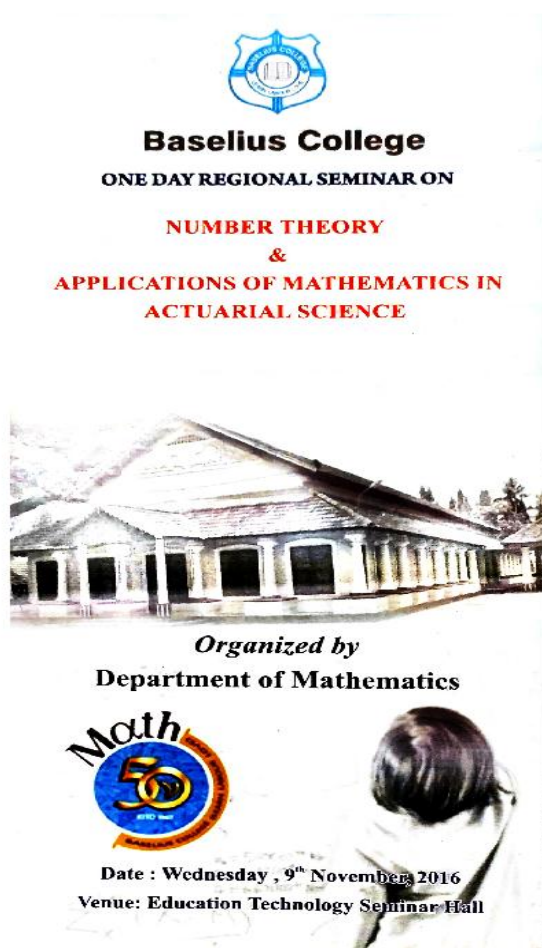

8. Seminar: “Number theory and Applications of Mathematics in Actuarial Science”

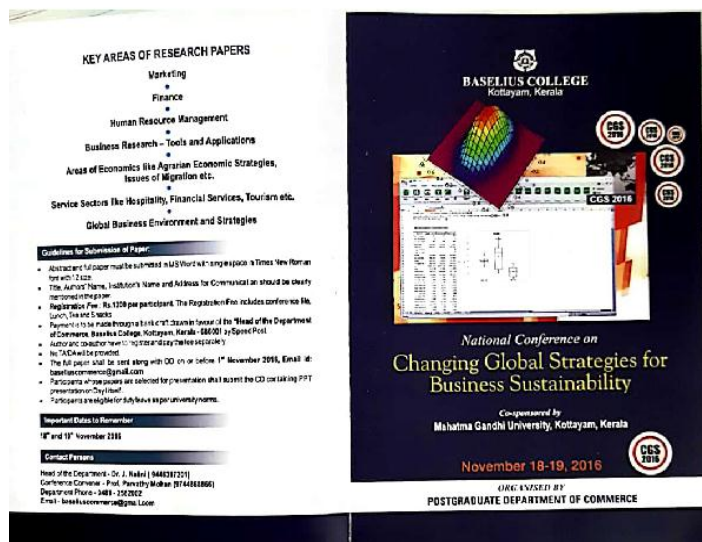

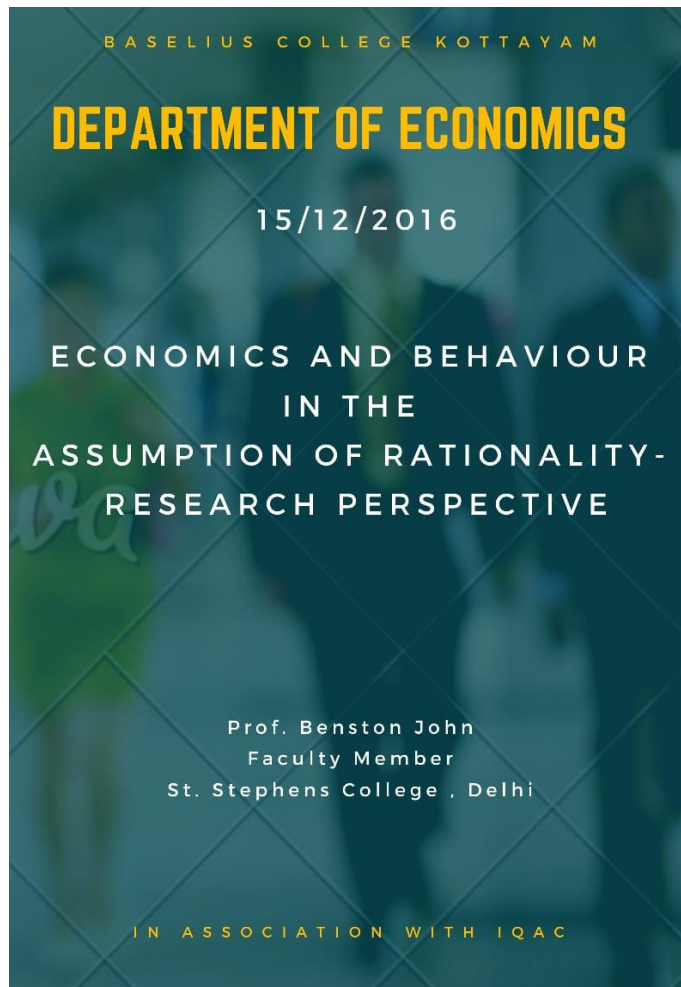

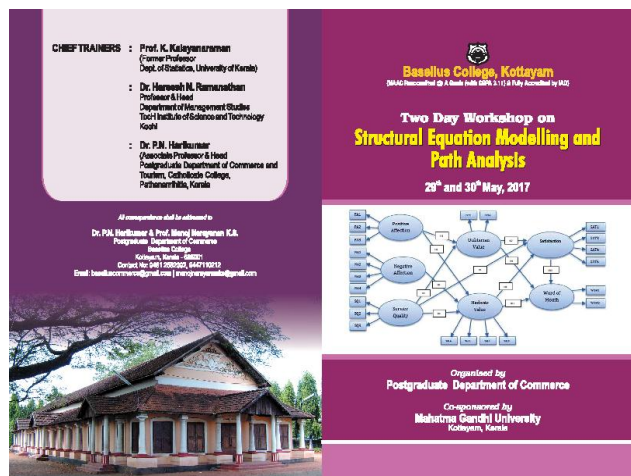
11. Workshop: “Research Methodology - MLA Eighth Edition”
