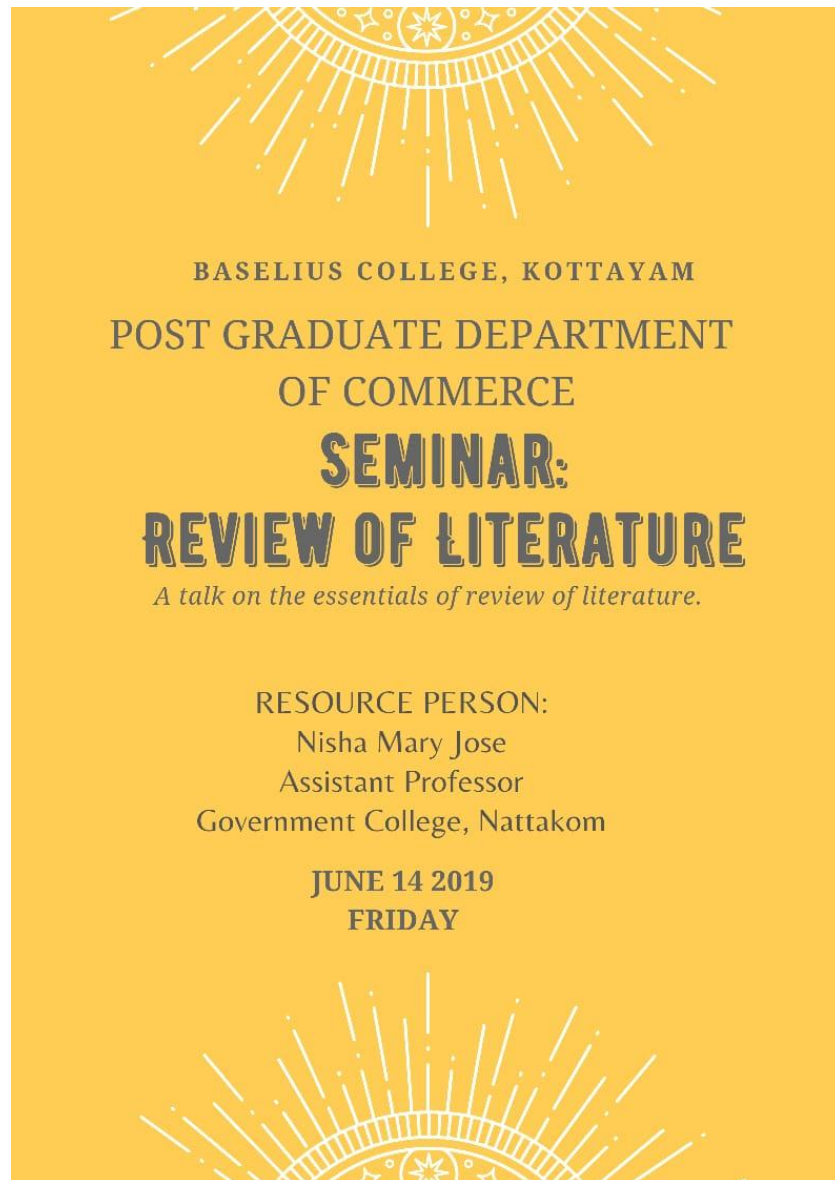
1. Seminar: Introduction to Research Methodology

Basileus College, Kottayam has been blessed with a galaxy of glittering teachers right from the day of its inception in 1964. Many of these great gurus have left us forever, but the fragrance of their memorial lives on in the minds of their innumerable students and several others who came in contact with them. **Prof. P. Rajaram Menon** was the doyen among these renowned academics. Born into the illustrious Pothambai family in Emkulam on 26th August 1917 as the son of Sri. Kerala Varma Thiruvipadur and Smt. Kurukavu, Prof. Menon had his professional debut in NSS College, Changanacherry. From there, he shifted to Catholicate College, Pathanamthitta in 1955. Eight years later, he moved over to Basileus College, then a fledgling institution, as the first Head of the Department of English. His invaluable contributions to the Department in the initial years of its development will remain etched in gold forever in the annals of the college. A great lover of learning, language and literature, he impressed his colleagues and students by his vast knowledge, impressive lectures and simple, austere lifestyle.

Prof. P. Rajaram Menon passed away on the 1st of July 2007. The Dept. of English has been organizing a memorial lecture every year, to honour this great teacher. Dr. Sukumar Athreya (2008), Dr. K.S. Radhakrishnan (2009), Dr. Jancy James (2010), Dr. Babu Paul (2011), Sri. T.P. Sreenivasan (2012), Dr. Siby James (2013), Dr. C. Gopinathan Pillai (2014), Prof. George Onakkur (2015), and Sri. B. Unnikrishnan (2016), Sri. Unni R. (2017), have all delivered their excellent discourses. Last year, Benjamin, well-known novelist and short story writer, delivered his lecture on “Malayali Diasporate Experience and Diasporic Literature”. This year Dr. Ambikasutan Mangad shall speak on ecological concerns within literature and the intricate relationship between literature and the environment.

Dr. Ambikasutan Mangad is a renowned Malayalam writer. Born in Bara village in Kasargod, he retired as the Head of the Department of Malayalam at Nehru Arts and Science College, Kanhangad. His literary contributions range from short stories to fictional novels in Malayalam. He has 50 books to his credits and has bagged many awards including Anikumar award, Ithal Puraskaram, and V. P. Sivakumar Keli Award. He is best known for his novel, Enmakaje, that brims with lyrical beauty as well as pathos which poignantly etches out the Endosutran victims of Kasargod. His other major works are Marakappile Theyyungal, Randu Malayangal, Satharana Veshangal, Kadu, Jeevitathinte Mudra and Othenante Vail to name a few. Mangad wrote the script and dialogues for the critically acclaimed movie, Kayyapada. He won the Kerala State Award for the best story for the telenovela, Commercial Break. He has also won the Ekasari Memorial Award for Commercial Break in 2009 and the Sathyaki Anuradana Cherukadha Award for Neeravayin in 2014.

Ms. Maya Menon is formerly Vice-Principal, Chinnmaya Vidyalaya. She is the daughter of Prof. P. Rajaram Menon. She is an exemplary teacher and an excellent administrator.

The Department of English organized Prof. Rajaram Memorial Lecture to honour the first Head of the Department Prof. Rajaram on 22nd August, 2019. Dr. Ambikasutan Mangad was the keynote speaker who spoke on the ecological concerns within literature and the intricate relationship between literature and the environment.

The keynote address by Dr. Ambikasutan Mangad took the audience to the milieu portrayed in Enmakaje, gave first-hand accounts of the plight of the people there, the apathy of the government, the little battles they initiate to stand up to the insensitivity of bureaucracy, and the tremors they try to create so as to invite attention of and trigger social commitment and action amongst the students.

An Interactive session followed and the students posed a number of questions to which Dr. Ambikasutan Mangad answered elaborately. The session proved to be fruitful as Dr. Mangad spoke from his experiences and the students could relate to the world that he was trying to portray. Number of Participants-110

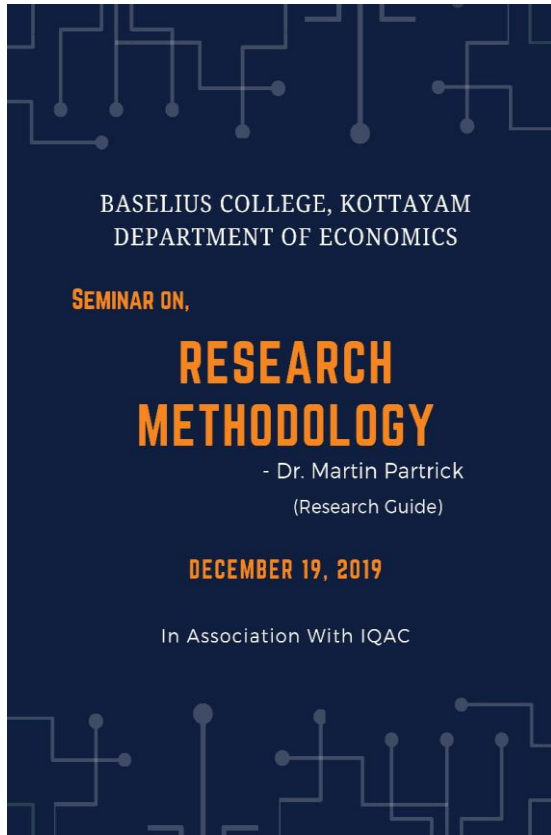
