## SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

#### 1. NAMASTE ENGLISH

## 3. STHREEPAKSHAM WORKSHOP




## 4. SANITIZER DISTRIBUTION

## 5. ENTE GRAMAM SUNDARA GRAM -BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT AT PANCHAYATH WARD



## 6. HONOURING THE COVID WARRIORS




## 8. ONAM KIT DISTRIBUTION


## 10.PANCHAYAT WASTE COLLECTION


## 11. CLEANING OF WATERBODIES








#### 17. ROAD SAFETY AWARENESS

## 18.HEALTH SURVEY AT MANARCADU




## 20.SNEHAVEEDU





