As part of the World Youth Day the volunteers of National Service Scheme of Baselius College conducted a cleaning program at Thirunakkara ground on 10/8/2017. Ninety students served for two hours to clean the place.



6. SwachchathaPakkhwada

NSS volunteers participated in the awareness drive for the Swatchatapakhwada at Kottayam Railway station on 15th August 2017.28 students participated in this program.



7. Flashmob

On the occasion of Independence Day, the students of Baselius college under the initiative of volunteers of National Service Scheme celebrated Independence Day,15/08/2017, and conducted a Flash mob at Kottayam railway station. 100 students participated in the celebrations that lasted for two hours.



8. Cleaning Activities At Public Library

Students of Baselius NSS volunteered for the cleaning activities of Public Library, Kottayam. 100 students participated in the project thatwas organized on 12/09/2017. Our volunteers dedicated four hours for the activity. The active participation of students attracted a lot of attention and media coverage.



9. Jaivam

Inspired by the Jaivam Project, the NSS unit took the initiative for starting an organic farm in the campus. Volunteers prepared all the arrangements and the initiative commenced on 19th September 2017. Due to the low-quality of seeds used and unfavourable climatic conditions, the efforts did not meet the expected result.

During the second stage, high quality seeds were collected from KozhaKrishiBavan. Volunteers worked hard to minimise the setbacks of the previous attempt. They were divided into groups and each group was entrusted with the responsibility to take care of the yield. This time, the efforts of the volunteers found better results. 20 students participated in this program.



10. Flash Mob at Railway Station

Volunteers of Baselius college National Service Scheme performed a flash mob in collaboration with Railway department, Kottayam. The event was conducted on 23/9/2017 and 50 students participated in the event.



11. Jaivam Survey

Jaivam 2017 is a Mahatma Gandhi University initiative to promote organic farming in Kottayam. The initiative included a campaign for transforming Kottayam District into 100% Literacy District in organic farming. It was conducted on 29/09/2017. 95 students participated in this program. NSS Volunteers conducted survey in Puthupally Grama-Panchayath during the Seven-Day camp as part of the ambitious project Jaivam 2017, an initiative of Mahatma Gandhi University. Groups of two volunteers each visited houses and uploaded the details through Jaivam app. The volunteers visited more than 4500 houses and collected the required data.






16. Zero Waste, Zero Waste Land






17. Blood Donation Camp
