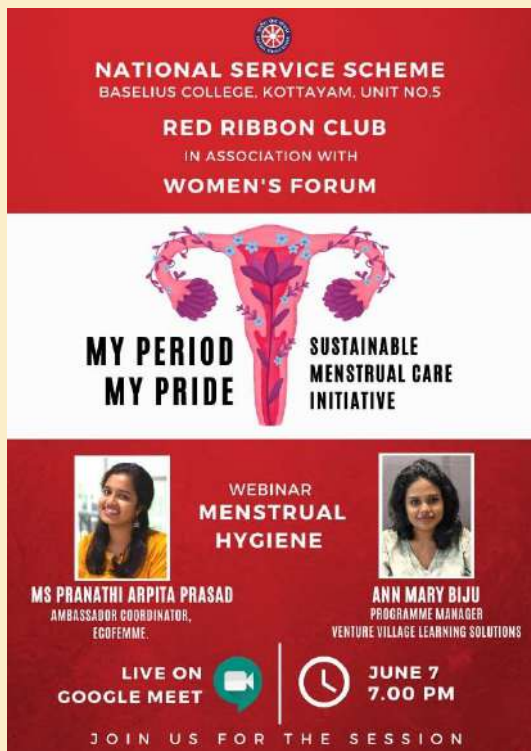

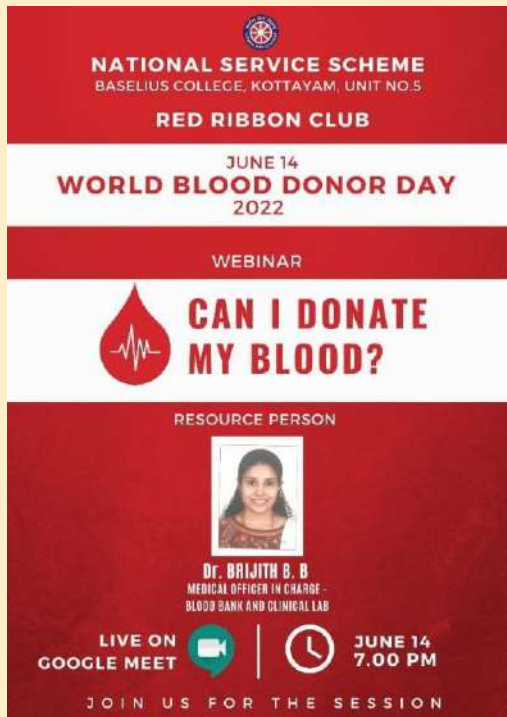
1) MY PERIOD MY PRIDE

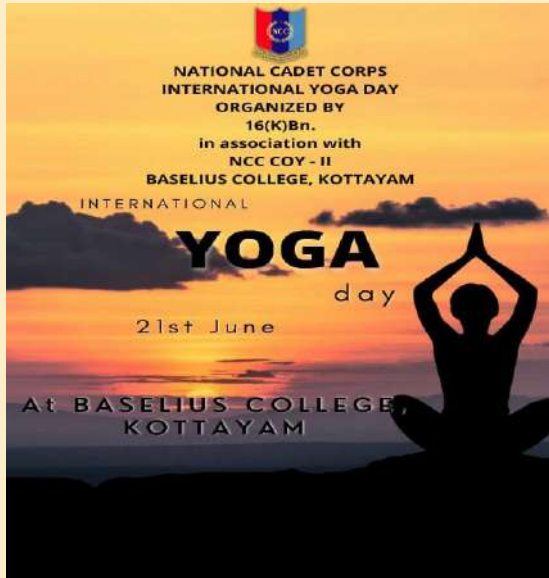
3) COUNTDOWN TO YOGA DAY

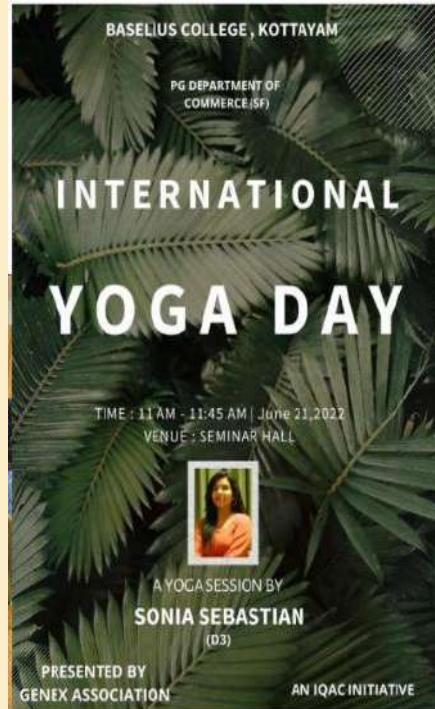


4) INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY

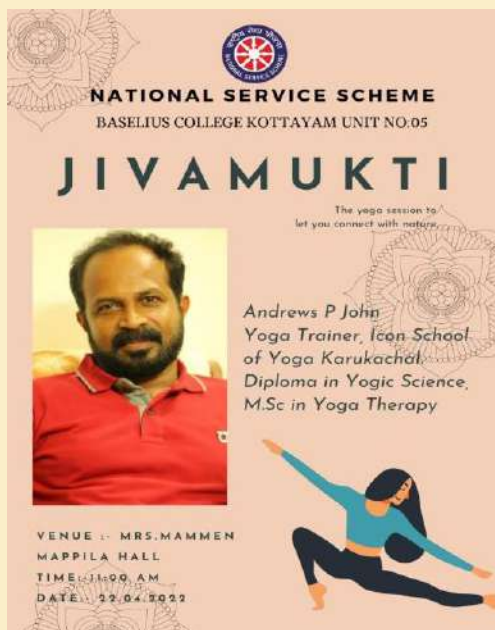



9) INTERDEPARTMENTAL COMPETITIONS -READERS' DAY

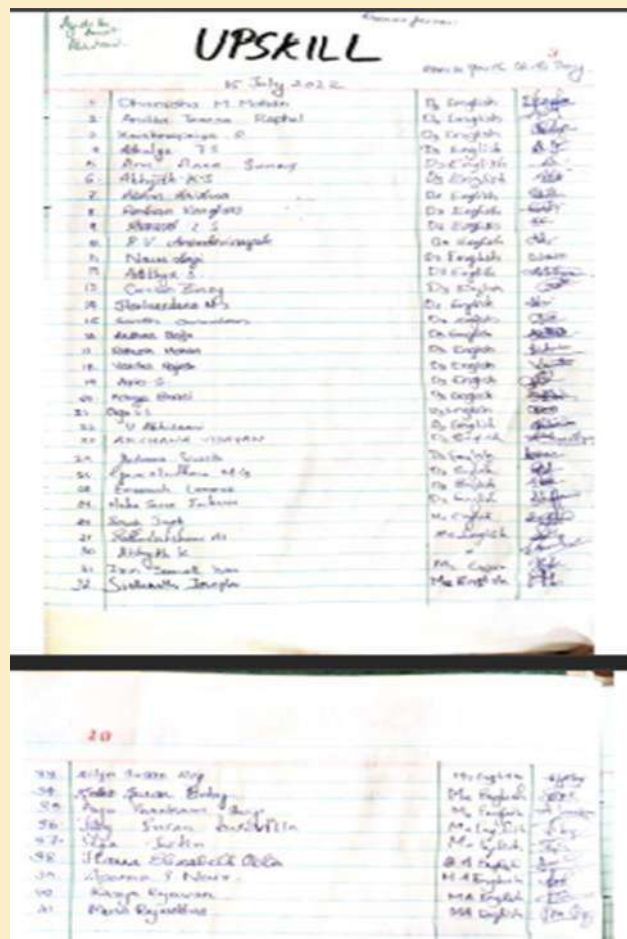
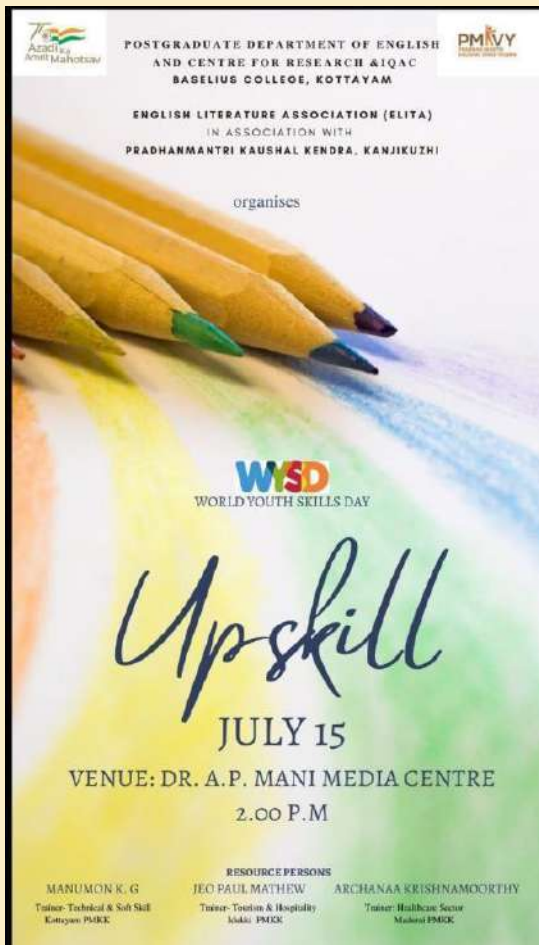

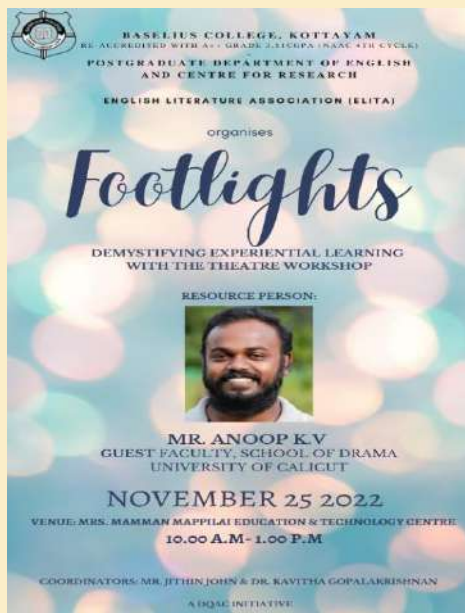




17) FOOTLIGHTS- DEMYSTIFYING EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING WITH THE THEATRE WORKSHOP

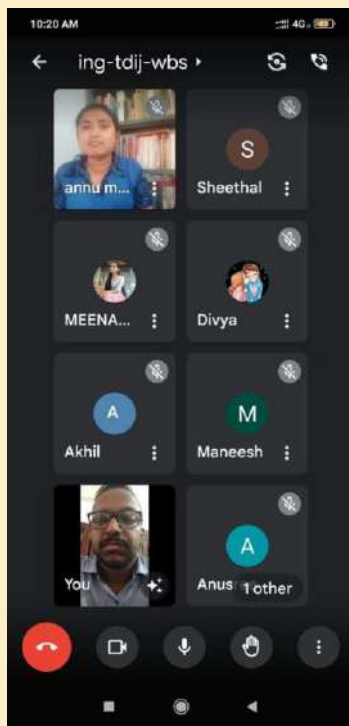
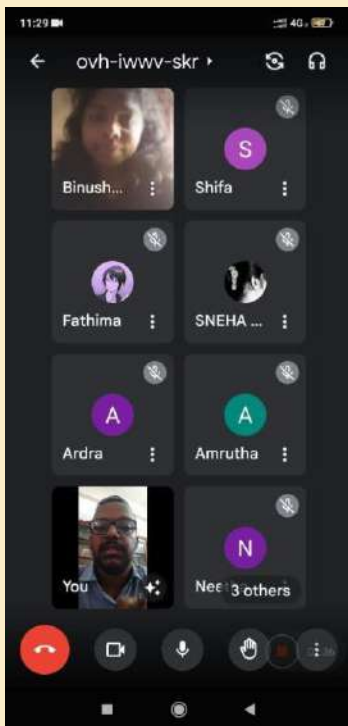


19) BODHA POORNIMA CLASSROOM DEBATES

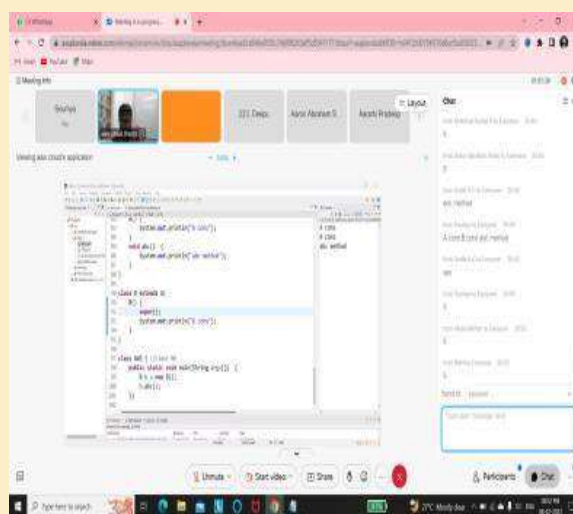

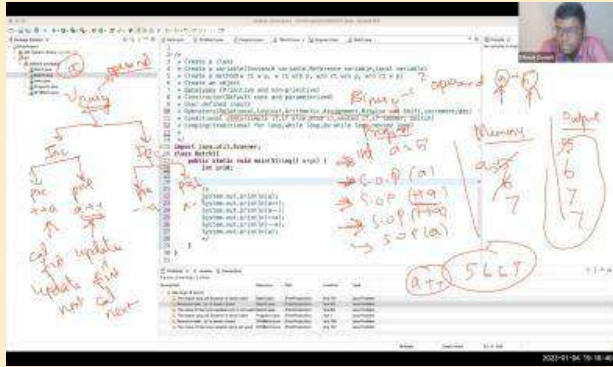

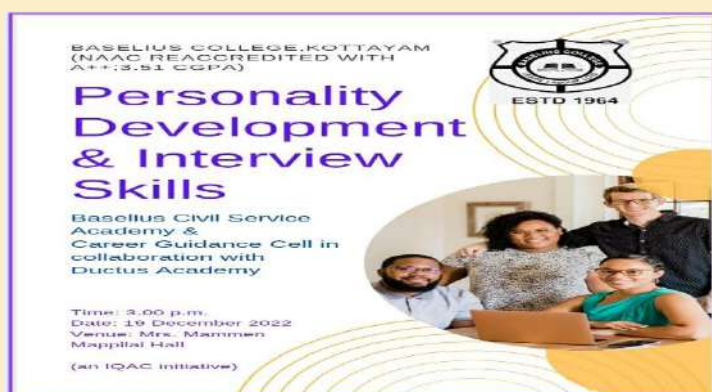
22) SKILL DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOP

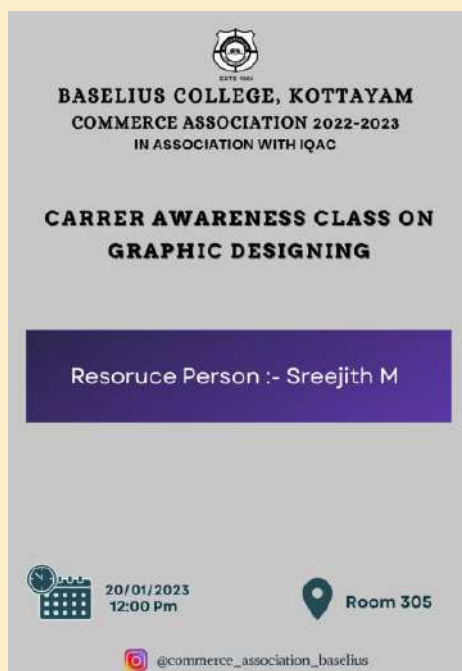
24) YULETIDE DREAMS - BASELIAN EXPO OF CHRISTMAS DÉCORS

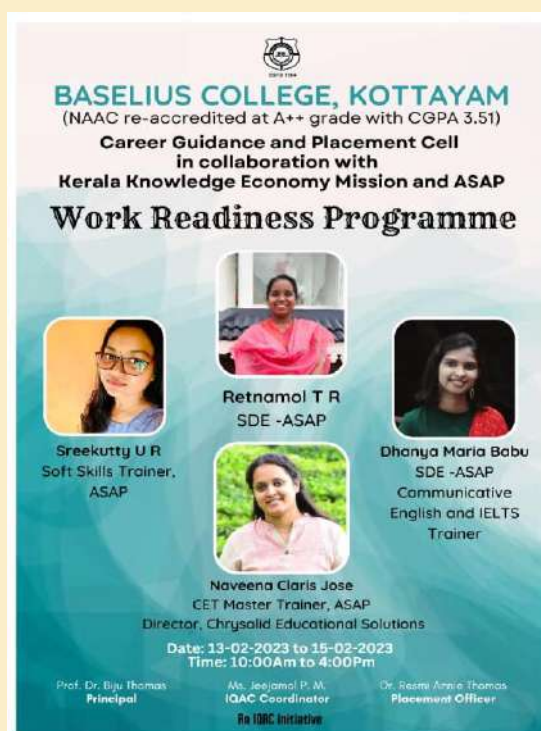
25) CAREER AWARENESS CLASS ON GRAPHIC DESIGNING

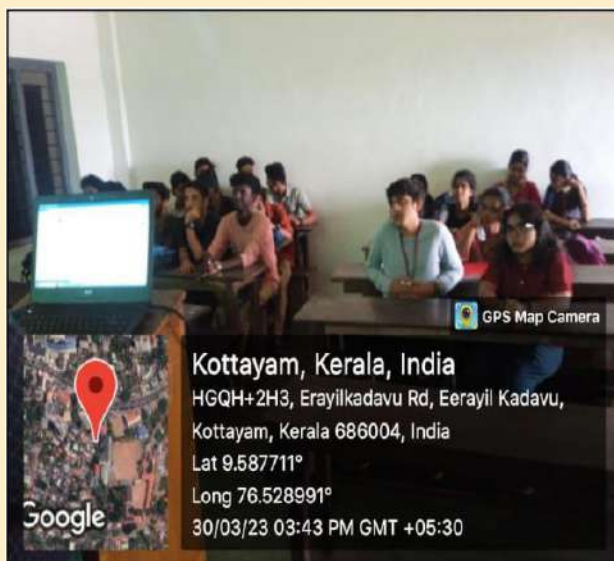
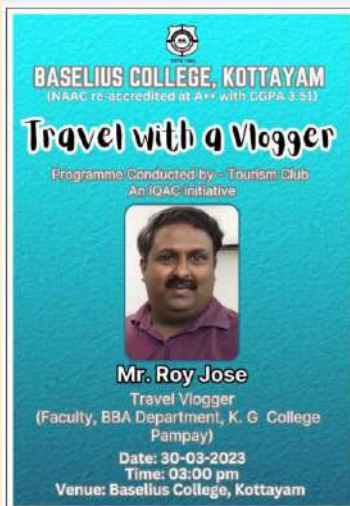
26) WORK READINESS PROGRAMME

28) WORKSHOP ON POSTER DESIGNING

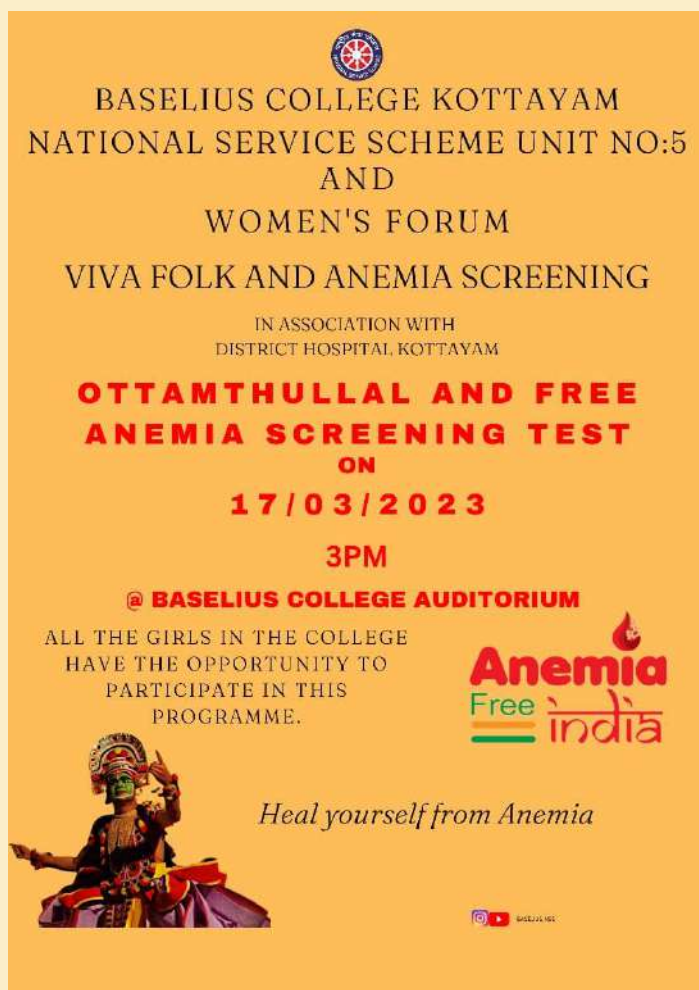

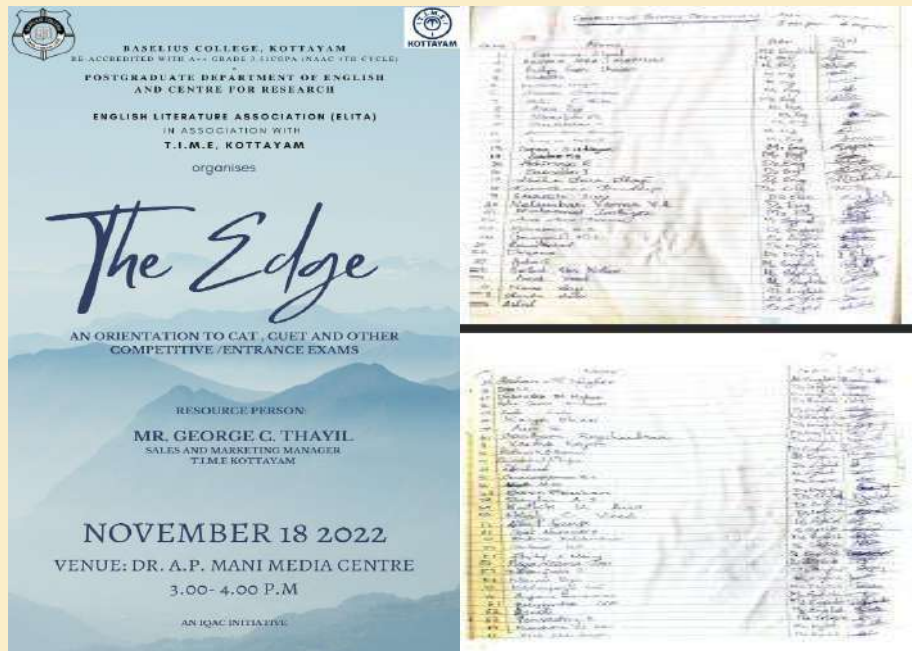
30) Big Talk- Moshanam 2024” Cast & Crew for Post- Launch Panel Discussion
