Last year, Benyamin, well-known novelist and short-story writer, delivered his lecture on "Malayali Expatriate Experience and Diasporic Literature". This year Dr. Ambikasutan Mangad shall speak on ecological concerns within literature and the intricate relationship between literature and the environment.



Dr. Ambikasutan Mangad is a renowned Malayalam writer. Born in Bara village in Kasargod, he retired as the Head of the Department of Malayalam at Nehru Arts and Science College, Kanhangad. His literary contributions range from short stories to fictional novels in Malayalam. He has 50 books to his credits and has bagged many awards including Ankanam award, Ithal Puraskaram, and V. P. Sivakumar Keli Award. He is best known for his novel, *Enmakaje*, that brims with lyrical beauty as well as pathos which poignantly etches out the Endosulfan victims of Kasargod. His other major works are *Marakkappile Theyyangal*, *Randu Malsyangal*, *Sadharana Veshangal*, *Rathri*, *Jeevithathinte Mudra* and *Othenante Vaal* to name a few. Mangad wrote the script and dialogues for the critically acclaimed movie, *Kaiyoppu*. He won the Kerala State Award for the best Story for the telefilm, *Commercial Break*. He has also won the Edasseri Memorial Award for *Commercial Break* in 2000 and the Sathyamal Anusmarana Cherukadha Award for *Neeraaliyan* in 2014.

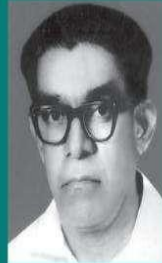

Santhosh George Kulangara is well known world traveller. Born in Marangattupilly in Kottayam district, he is the founder and Managing Director of Safari channel. The programs in the channel aesthetically blends history, travel, places and people and stands out giving unique experience to the Malayali audience all over the world. He proved his mettle by becoming the head of Labour India Publications Ltd., which is the largest educational publication in Kerala at a young age of 26. He amazed the Kerala audience through his signature infotainment program, Sancharam, the first visual travelogue in Malayalam. Produced, directed and edited by a single person, he has entered Limca Book of World Records. He also has to his credit of being selected as the first Indian to a highly selective group of space tourists in 2007. He has bagged many awards- Kerala Sahitya Academi Award for Best Travelogue in 2012. Asian Television Award for the best director, K.R. Narayanan Award, Kerala Film Critics' award for the best television programme director, Yuva Prathibha Award for the year 2004 are some of them. *Natashayude Varna Balloonukal*, *Oru Rabbayude Chumbanangal*, *Ground Zeroyle Gayakan* are just some of his major works. He is a bilingual writer and has many books to his credit. *Ripples and Pebbles* (1989), *Sprouts of Indignation* (2003) and *Magic Chasm* (2007) are his collections of his poems. *The Haunted Man*, *Upon This Bank and Shoal*, *When Babel Tower is Falling Down* are his noted novels; the latter two published by CCB Publishing, British Columbia, Canada. *Poles Apart on the Same Bed* (short story collection), *And Still Plays the Abyssinian Damsel on her Dulcimer* (novel), *The Psycho-Social Interface in British Fiction* (critical work) are testimonies of his expertise in handling different genres of literature. He is currently Professor of English at University of Gondar in Ethiopia.

She was a research scholar at the Institute of English, ardent in her studies, until her sad demise on the 29th of August 2006.



Dr. J. Devika is a much acclaimed feminist researcher and teacher at the Centre for Development Studies, Kerala, who has contributed to our understanding of the history of gender, development, politics, and culture of modern Kerala. Her work is interdisciplinary opening up the boundaries between academic and public discourses. Her research on Kerala has been published in global, national, and local journals. She is also a translator of literature and social science writing both in Malayalam and English. She writes occasionally for children, besides offering commentary on contemporary politics in Kerala on www.kafila.org. *En-gendering Individuals: The Language of Re-forming in Twentieth Century Keralam*, *Her Self: Early Writings on Gender by Malayalee Women 1898-1938*, *Kulasthreeyum Chanthappennum Undaayathengine?* and *Woman writing=Manreading?* are some of her notable works.

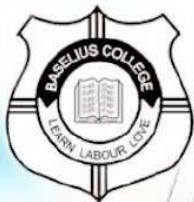





The illustrious and eminent professor, M C Jacob took the helm of department in 1969. Under his stewardship the department was hailed as one of the best Commerce Departments in the erstwhile Kerala University. The milestones of this department often coincided with that of the college itself. It is with the launch of M.Com programme in the Department, in 1981 that the college was elevated to the level of first grade College.

Professor M C Jacob was born on the 23rd of September 1932 as the son of Late Sri M.M.Chandy and Late Smt. Susamma Chandy. He did his schooling from CMS College High School and completed his graduation from S.D College Alappuzha. He obtained his Post Graduation from the Dept. of Commerce, Banaras Hindu University and started his career as a lecturer in the Department of Commerce, Fathima Matha College, Kollam and later on served as a faculty of Dept. of Commerce, S D College Alappuzha. Our Department of Commerce had been fortunate to have his eminent and motivating presence from 1967 to 1988.



Dr. Saji Gopinath

Dr. Saji Gopinath is the first vice chancellor of Kerala University of Digital Sciences, Innovation and Technology. His education, academic and industrial exposure is noteworthy. He gained his Ph. D in Management studies with specialisation in Finance and M. Tech from Indian Institute of Science (IISc) Bangalore. His wide range of experience in premier institutes include his positions as Professor and Dean in Indian Institute of Management Kochi (IIM K), where his interest was teaching, research, consulting and he developed a network micro enterprise which had supported over 700 families to emerge out of poverty. 

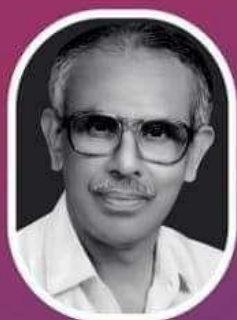
