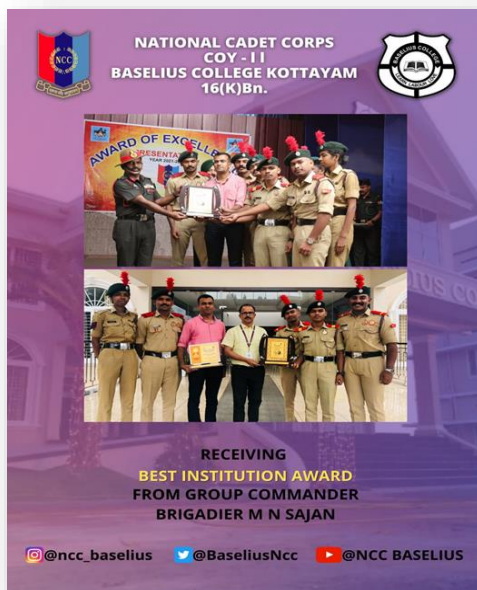
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ACTIVITIES & ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE YEAR

INTERNAL EXAM AS PART OF CONTINUOUS INTERNAL EVALUATION

Internal Assessment is an integral part of student assessment and grading for both UG and PG programmes. For UG programmes, Internal Evaluation constitutes 20 % of the total score and for PG Programmes, it is 25 %. The components of internal assessment and the regulations are clearly laid down in the syllabus documents. The students are given proper awareness regarding internal assessment at the time of their induction and initial orientation programmes itself. The schedules of internal assessment components such as test papers, seminars, assignments, and viva voce etc. are also made known to the students in advance. A teacher is assigned for each course who will be responsible for the evaluation of various components of the assessment process. Assignments and seminars are evaluated by the course teacher and the performances are discussed with the students. Regarding the test papers, after the scores are published, the performances of the students are discussed, and re-examinations are offered if needed. The Internal Assessment scores and grades are published for the student verification by the course -in charge before the commencement of the end-semester examinations. The students verify and give their nod if they are satisfied by signing the document.

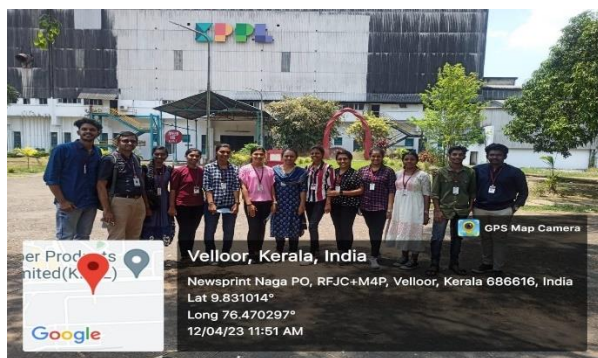



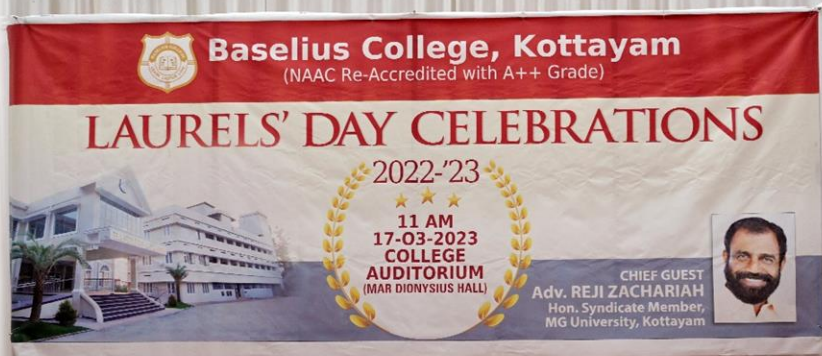

ALUMNI

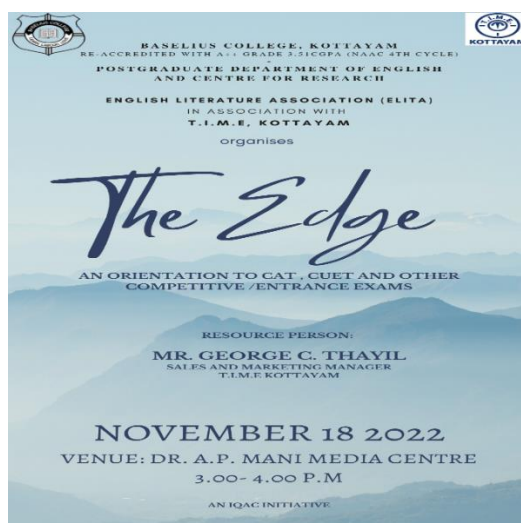

COACHING FOR NET, COMPETATIVE EXAMS ETC. & CAREER ORIENTATON PROGRAMMES

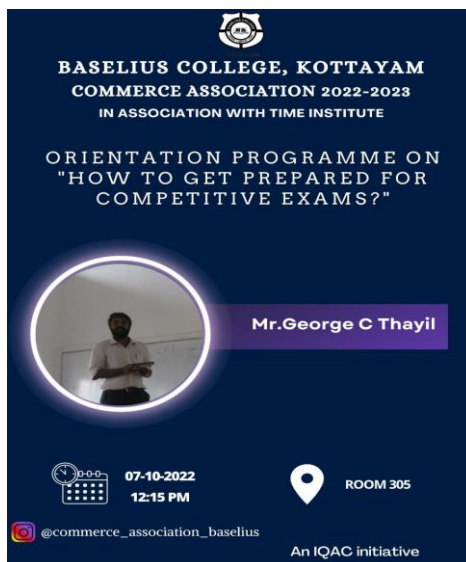
1. The Edge- Orientation Programmes to competitive exams

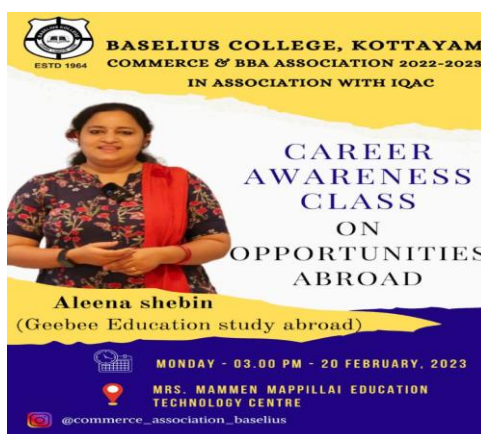
6. Orientation on SAP

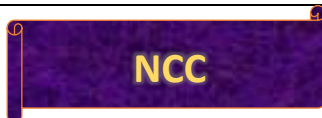

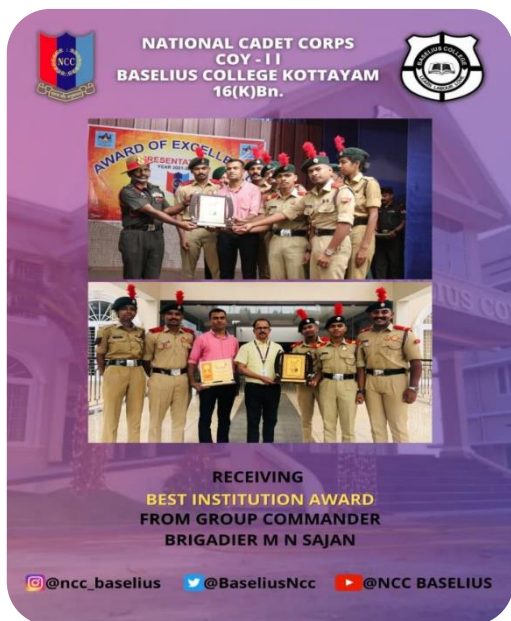

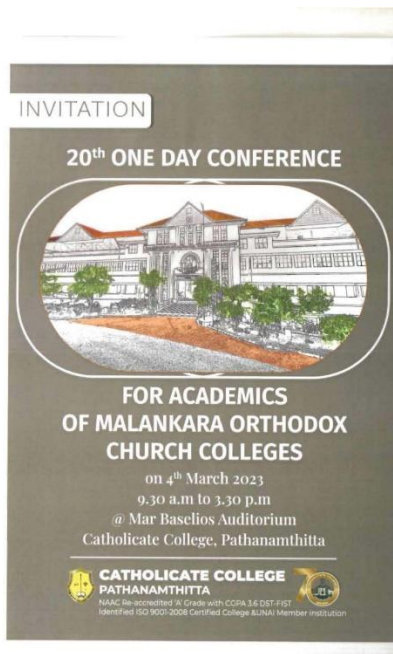

GO GREEN INITIATIVES

1. SWACHH BHARAT PAKHWADA - 01/06/2022

SwachhtaPakhwada was Started in April 2016, with the objective of bringing a fortnight of intense focus on issues and practices of the Swachhta by engaging all the government ministries & departments in their jurisdictions.

Background

This is an environment awareness campaign launched under Swachh Bharat Mission. It was launched to achieve the goal of total sanitizations and cleanliness by October 2, 2019. Department of English

1. Department of Chemistry

- o Micro scale techniques in the UG and PG laboratory - Microscale techniques in the laboratory: In spite of not being stipulated in the syllabus, we are doing the UG and PG practical in a

microscale way. This reduces the use of chemicals, thus reducing the pollution and cost of the experiments. In addition, it creates awareness among students regarding environmental pollution.

o In house journal - The free Radicals: UG students are encouraged to prepare research articles as part of the in-house journal, which creates an interest in research.

o Curies Conclave - Presenting PowerPoint presentations on topics of their own interest and showing relevant video presentations are two activities that make the students feel enthusiastic about Chemistry

o Basechem spellistry competition: A unique interschool, intercollegiate competition aimed at improving students vocabulary and knowledge in chemistry and thereby forging them into a wordsmith. Students from various colleges and schools participate in the competition. Preparation for Spellistry is a comprehensive learning process that allows children to learn the definition and pronunciation of the word. This information will greatly enhance the knowledge base of a child, and motivate them to develop a keen interest in learning new words. It also provides an opportunity for students to meet and compete with their peers in an atmosphere of fun and friendship.
