2. A Brief write-up

- a. NCC Baselius Unit had come up with an awareness video based on the theme of world environment day 2020 that is 'celebrate biodiversity'. Our cadets cast in the video following the covid protocols and decided to plant and protect biodiversity under the hashtag #justiceforenvironment.
- b. June 21 is celebrated as International Yoga Day. NCC unit of Baselius College also takes part in the celebration by conducting Yoga classes. This year, Yoga day was celebrated online. Cadets were given instructions and the importance of Yoga in their day to day life. Cadets had done Yoga in their home along with their parents and siblings and pictures were sent.
- c. In association with the hashtag movement on Environment Day, #justiceforenvironment, cadets planted trees in their surroundings on 14th July 2020 and are being protected. Through this, our cadets are trying to convey that certain things like looking after our environment are not only meant for a particular day but also to follow up and cherish them lifelong for a better environment.
- d. July 26 is remembered as Kargil Vijay Diwas in remembrance of the victory of Kargil Day. Our cadets prepared a tribute video for all those martyrs in Kargil War and salute all army men who are always awake for the nation. Cultural programs and competitions were held for cadets online under four companies (Alpha, Bravo, Charlie), in which all cadets have participated.
- e. 72nd Independence Day was celebrated on 15th August 2020 at college. The numbers of cadets that can present were permitted to only 5. The flag was hoisted by the head of the Department of Mathematics, who was the chief guest of the programme, Prof. Shibu M George, Caretaker, Dr Viju Kurien, NSS Programme Officer. On the day, we remembered all the freedom fighters and also the warriors fighting against Covid-19. Cultural programme, messages and tribute video presentation were done online and this made all cadets be part of the Independence Day Celebrations.
- f. To make India self-reliable, the honourable Prime Minister of India put forward the concept of Aatma Nirbhar Bharat. To spread this concept among people, our cadets had done online campaigns and awareness programs throughout August 2020. They spoke out about the self-reliable nation and the contributions each citizen can make to it.
- g. As part of Swach Bharath Pakhwada our unit has been indulging in various cleaning activities for the past few years this year also our cadets cleaned their home and its premises following all covid protocols.

- h. FIT India movement proposed by the Honourable prime minister to discover the new you by including physical activities and sports in daily lives. our cadets took part in the Fit India campaign to make them aware of the importance of a healthy lifestyle. The last week of August 2020 and the first week of September 2020 were the periods in which our cadets campaigned. They follow their exercises even after the period.

2. Brief write-up:

a. As part of maintaining COVID -19 safety Our 5 cadets were deployed on duty under the Kottayam district collector based on EX -NCC Yogdan under 16 {k} Bn. SUO Arjun Gopakumar, UO Athul Varkey Eapen, CSM Amarnath M P, SGT Muhammed Hariz and SGT Pranav P Pradeep gone to various places along with collectorate officers and took a survey from interstate workers for providing an anti-COVID-19 response, to help Civil administration during the lockdown period, from 17 to 20 April 2020 and contributed their service to the nation successfully.

b As part of surveys conducted by the central Government, for upbringing the local areas and citizens livelihood, our cadets visited the houses of Vijayapuram Panchayath and collected the details as per the Unnath Bharath survey. The survey was held on 6, 7 and 8 March 2020. Cadets were divided into three groups and were sent along with seniors. The collected data were uploaded to the Central Government site of Unnath Bharath Abhiyan.

- **c.** As part of the **Rebuild Kerala Project- a Biodiversity Survey** was conducted by the State Biodiversity Board. Our cadets were called to collect data from plant nurseries and ayurvedic shops. The details collected were added to ODK, an app and excel sheets were prepared with the data collected has been handed over to the respective authority.
- **d.** Our Cadets were designated as volunteers for the 'NAVA KERALAM CM@CAMPUS' program initiated by the Kerala govt, held at MG University campus on 08/02/2021. The cadets have done a commendable job for the smooth functioning of the programme.
- **e.** Our Cadets took part in cleaning and maintaining the war memorial at Kottayam collectorate, which contains names of 03 Officers, 02 JCOs and 33 Martyrs including 01 PVC from Kottayam district who have made the supreme sacrifice in the highest traditions of the

Armed forces of the country. The programme was jointly conducted by NCC cadets of both Baselius College and M D Seminary School under 16 (k) Bn. As a tribute.

- **f.** 20 Cadets of the Unit were deployed for election duty to support and helping the district administration to manage the officials at the distribution centre of Polling materials, MD Seminary HSS Kottayam on 05/04/2021 for welcoming the polling officers and on 06/04/2021 for ensuring the welfare and crowd control of polling personal.
