## FIELD VISIT REPORT

## INTRODUCTION

As per the curriculum of Mahatma Gandhi University, it was necessary for B.SC. Botany to visit to any one of the ecosystems rich in Algae to experience algal diversity as a part of the course Methodology of Science and an Introduction to Botany (BO1CRT01) and Phycology and Bryology (BO3CRT03) .Department of Botany, Baselius College planned, and organized such a field visit which helped the student to increase interest in algal diversity. The Visit was organized with prior permission and guidance of Dr. Biju Thomas, Principal (Baselius College) and Prof.Arabhi P., HOD. The Final year B.Sc. Botany students of Baselius College participated in this visit. The 39 students and four staff members visited Thirumullavarum, Kollam district on $8^{\text {th }}$ June 2019.

## OBJECTIVES

- To identify and collect plant specimens to appreciate the diversity of plant kingdom.
- To identify plants with vascular elements, plants which produce flowers, fruits, seeds, cone, sporophyll, embryos and study their salient features.
- To experience algal diversity.

Marine ecosystem exploration and algal collection trip, were conducted to Thirumullavarum, Kollam district on $8^{\text {th }}$ June 2019, accompanied by three teaching staff (Dr Geethalakshmi, K, Dr Sajish PR, Dr Krishnaraj M V ) and one laboratory assistant (Varghese A.M.) Students collected marine algae and learned about their distribution pattern.

The Visit was organized with prior permission and guidance of Dr. Biju Thomas, Principal (Baselius College) and Prof.Arabhi P., HOD. The Final year B.Sc. Botany students of Baselius College participated in this visit. The students and three staff members visited M.S. Swamynathan Research Foundation, Puthurvayal, Wayanad, Balur and Mysore on 31/01/2019.

## OBJECTIVES

- Visit to any forests types including grasslands and preparation of the list of Rare and threatened (R\&T) plants
- Conduct a field visit to any one of the ecosystems/ botanic gardens to experience the plant diversity.



## FIELD TRIP TO KNOW NATURE (31.1.2019 TO 4.02.2019)

A field visit was conducted on 31.1.2019 to 4.02.2019 with our D3 students to MSSRF, Puthoorvayal, Wayanad, Mysore and Belur as part of curriculum Students collected plants from the rural vegetation and preserved it for haerbarium preparation. They also got an opportunity to see many plants in the field that were known to them earlier only through names. They received a class from the scientific staff of MS Swaminathan Research Federation, Puthoorvayal, Wayanadu regarding the various activities of the institution, why and how it established etc. Later students visited the premises of MSSRF with special emphasis to conservatory and tissue culture Laboratory. Dr. M. V. Krishnaraj, Prof. Arabhi P. and Mr. A M Varghese were accompanied the study tour.

## STUDY TOUR 2018-‘19

The tour of D3 Zoology for the year 2018-19 was conducted for three days starting from $16^{\text {th }}$ January, 2019. The first day of the tour was strictly academics oriented. The journey began at $5.00 \mathrm{a} . \mathrm{m}$. on $14^{\text {th }}$ January and all 32 students along with 2 teachers and a lab assistant comprised the tour party. The first destination was Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute (CMFRI), Ernakulum. The students got an opportunity to learn about the marine biodiversity as well as various methods on conserving the diversity. The institute provided demonstration sessions on electron microscopy and processing of food fishes. The students were shown aquariums with marine fishes and a museum with preserved specimens ranging from sponges to higher animals. Small lectures were given on topics like, 'How pearl is secreted by an oyster', as well as a detailed lecture with samples on how to determine the age of a fish. Later, the students had some leisure time at Marine drive. They were taken into the open sea in a cruise boat with a dance floor.

The next destination was Chikmaglur and the group reached there on the morning of January $15^{\text {th }}$ morning and checked in to Hotel Raj Mahal Orchid. After breakfast the students along with the teachers and staff were taken for a jeep trekking into the Chikmaglur hills. On the way the group halted at several scenic spots taking in the mesmerizing beauty of the hills.

On $16^{\text {th }}$ January morning the group started to Belur, the next destination. After spending some time at the Belur temple, the group left to Coorg. The students were taken for river rafting and they spent an hour in the lake.
