 - The Principal informed the members about the reconstituted IQAC and introduced the members.
 - Dr Manoj Narayanan K S presented the summary of activities undertaken till November. The follow up action on the implementation of decisions taken in the previous meeting was also discussed.



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Meeting Discussions and Action Taken

1. Approval of the revised plan of action and revised academic calendar was given and it was decided to conduct orientations, FDPs, Student Support Programmes etc. in online mode till normalcy is restored.
 2. It was decided to conduct Academic Audit for 2019-20 in March or April, depending on the restrictions that might be available. Dr Jojo K Joseph, Principal, Devamatha College, Kuravilangadu, who is also a NAAC peer team member shall be invited to head the Academic and Administrative Audit team.
 3. An Orientation for the teachers shall be arranged in connection with the revised NAAC accreditation process.
 4. It was decided to participate in the NIRF and ARIIA ranking process.
 5. All mentors shall be directed to contact their mentees and prepare a report based on the well-being of the students.
 6. Students shall be given the directions to register in the National Academic Depository (NAD) and also shall be encouraged to submit the online Anti-ragging form and make this a routine practice.
 7. It was decided to continue the Best practices in online mode, wherever possible, without bringing a disruption to the activities.
 8. Decided to conduct training sessions in emerging areas like Business Data Analytics, Software application in Research, Careers and Higher Education avenues etc.

- Presidential Address by Principal
 - The Principal informed the members about the reconstituted IQAC and introduced the members.
 - Faculty members who got PhD were appreciated.
 - The Principal specifically pointed out the instance of B Com 1996-99 batch helping in the installation of a smart board in B Com class and for the institution of scholarships for needy.



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- Dr Jyothimol P presented a summary of activities from June to August.
- Dr Manoj Narayanan K S presented the status of reports to be prepared in connection with the accreditation. He informed the members regarding the difficulty posed by the pandemic and non-conclusion of the academic year. The follow up action on the implementation of decisions taken in the previous meeting was also discussed.

Meeting Decisions and Actions Taken

1. Approval of the plan of action and revised academic calendar. It was decided to bring necessary revision in the calendar as the University has not yet announced a detailed schedule and the admission process has just started and the first semester classes of UG and PG have not yet been commenced.
2. Decision was taken regarding completion of the beautification work of the college ground. Based on the suggestion of Sri Jacob Kuruvilla, it was decided to draft a proposal for the utilisation of the ground and the facilities to the selected public, post covid restrictions, as a part of an outreach programme.
3. It was also decided to organise Faculty Development Programmes in online mode relating to areas like Quality Assurance, MOODLE training etc.
4. Tutors shall make use of their tutorial interaction session to provide necessary information regarding the avenues open for the students in the online era.
5. It was decided to strengthen the mentoring process and to do proper follow up at the department level where special attention and care are required for many students.
6. Teachers shall add to the e-material repository. A detailed list of ICT usage by teachers was to be collected.
7. The meeting ratified and approved the decision implemented namely upgrading the internet facilities and installation of more wifi routers.
8. It was also decided to motivate teachers to join FDP/Orientation/Refresher Programmes etc. The IQAC convener was entrusted to provide recommendations in consultation with the convener of Research Assessment Committee for the re-imbursement of expenses incurred by the teachers for attending / presenting in the conference.
9. Support of alumni may be sought to convert more class rooms into smart class rooms. Encourage teachers to participate in FDPs, short term programmes etc. in addition to Orientation and Refresher Courses. Thrust shall be given on Programmes that help to improve the E-teaching learning skills of the teachers.




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10. It was also decided to approve the proposals for undertaking more infrastructural works with management funds along with the RUSA construction.
 11. The meeting also decided to re start the AQAR and SSR works once the normalcy is restored. The IQAC cum NAAC coordinator pointed out the difficulties faced in finalisation and approval of the documents mentioned above. It was decided that once the normal course of activity is fully restored, IIQA may be given in three months.
 12. The meeting also discussed the feedbacks collected from various stakeholders during 2019-20 in detail. Wherever possible, internships, experiential learning facilities, OJT etc. have to be encouraged and also made a compulsory course. The meeting decided to bring the suggestions to the concerned BoS through formal and informal discussions.
 13. The Annual Report 19-20 presented was approved and it was decided to make necessary modifications based on the additional information received later.
 14. To recommend and approve the application for M Sc Data Analytics and Master of Commerce and Management as the two proposed Programmes.
 15. Decided to promote the conduct of online examinations, both through MCQ software and also descriptive online mode.

 - Appraised the members on the situation on account of the pandemic
 - Informed the members about the various activities undertaken during the lockdown period by the staff and the students
 - The collection of data from the students during the time of pandemic and distribution of financial assistance to the needy students was also informed.

Meeting Discussions and Action Taken

1. The survey report of students on the Teaching Learning Process, Infrastructure, Library and the curriculum was presented.
2. It was decided to give more importance to the cleanliness and maintenance of infrastructure, once the pandemic situation is over. That particular aspect has received the lowest rating.
3. It was also noted that some students lacked awareness regarding the proper way of informing grievances to the authorities which result in delayed settlement of issues, though most of those related to non-availability of water supply in pipes, improper working of switches or fans, leakages etc. It was decided to make the students aware of the mechanism for grievance lodging to the authorities.
4. It was also decided to provide more facilities in the library and promote more students to make use of the e-facilities in the library. The internet facilities in the library has to be augmented
5. It was also decided to augment the internet connectivity speed and arrange more Wi-Fi facilities at the department as online classes are likely to stay for some time.



7. Establishment of a computer lab cum smart class room in the newly constructed Students Amenities Centre and seeking financial assistance from





Meeting Discussions and Action Taken

1. Decided to speed up the setting up of an Institutional LMS, based on Moodle platform.
2. Classes and orientation to be given to the students on the ill effects of use of drugs. Some members pointed out that there are many media reports which highlight that many college students are massively using drugs. So, sensitisation programmes have to be conducted.
3. Providing leaflets to the students regarding the process of NAAC accreditation, its importance and the role of students.
4. Teachers shall be motivated to provide more e-resources to the students and the links of various you tube lectures shall be uploaded in the website and shared in the student WhatsApp groups.



Dr. P. Balanarayan is a computational and theoretical chemist working as an Assistant Professor at the Department of Chemical Sciences, Indian Institute of Science Education and Research (IISER), Mohali. His group (QMG@IISER-Mohali) is involved in the development of methods for enabling computations of electronic dynamics in atoms and molecules in the presence of high intensity laser fields. Their recent research focus has been on stabilizing transition states of model chemical reactions by using a laser sufficiently strong enough to induce major electronic effects. Currently, the group is developing methodology and a package suite (ADELPHI) that can carry out such calculations from an ab initio point of view.

His research interests include issues relating to economic growth and development, globalization, international trade and trade policy, regional integration, competitiveness, South Asia. 
Yago Aranda Larrey




