

Findings


- It has a milk handling capacity of 100000 litre/day.
- Only Milk, Curd, Gee and Sambharam were the products produced by the Milma Dairy Unit, Thrissur.
- 86000 litres of milk are being collected and brought to the unit, from other places.
- There were various categories of milk produced in the unit such as Homogenized Toned Milk, Milma Rich Milk, Milma Smart Milk, Milma Lite, etc.
- Six tankers of milk arrive to the unit at different time schedules, daily.

STUDY TOUR SUMMARY

Place - Goa

30-01-2023 to 04-02-2023

Classes – D3 Commerce, D3 BBA and M2 Commerce

The Department of Commerce and Business Administration at Baselius College, Kottayam organized a study tour to Goa for the students of D3 Commerce, D3 BBA, and M2 Commerce. The tour took place from 30th January 2023 to 3rd February 2023. The objective of the tour was to provide students with exposure to the industry and cultural aspects of Goa.

DAY 1 DATE -30-01-2023

The tour began on 31-01-2023 from Baselius College Kottayam around 9:45am under the guidance of Prof. Dr. Manoj Narayanan K. S. to Ernakulam by a private bus (Ave Mariya). A total of two buses were allotted for the journey. The group reached Ernakulam South Railway Station by 12:15pm. The train to Goa – Mangaldweep Express -12677 departed at 1:30pm. After spending around 13 hours in the train, the tour party reached the destination on Day two.

DAY 2 -31-01-2023

The train reached Madgoan Station at early morning 4:25 am. The travel agent Ajo led the group/crew from Madgoan Station and dropped the crew at Palm Resort and checked in by 5:15am. After a fresh up the students was ready for their breakfast. The menu for the breakfast was puri with vegetable curry and bread and jam along with chai. After the breakfast all the students were taken to the NIT GOA for the industrial visit. The institutional visit was held on 31-01-2023. At around 10:30 am the visit was start. PG DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE (SF) FIELD VISIT REPORT

INTRODUCTION

As per the curriculum of Mahatma Gandhi University, it was necessary for final year degree students to visit to a local area to document environmental grassland/ hill /mountain as a part of the course ENVIRONMENT MANAGEMENT AND HUMAN RIGHTS (CO5CRT15). Department of Commerce (Self Financing), Baselius College planned, and organized such a field visit which helped the student to increase interest in environmental issues. The Visit was organized with prior permission and guidance of Dr. Biju Thomas, Principal (Baselius College) and Dr. Joy Markose, HOD. The Final year B.Com. students of Baselius College participated in this visit. The 44 students and three staff members visited Kumarakom, one of the beautiful ecosystems of Kerala on 21st October 2022.

OBJECTIVES

- Environmental Education encourages students to research, investigate how and why
 things happen, and make their own decisions about complex environmental issues by
 developing and enhancing critical and creative thinking skills.
- Environmental Education helps students to understand how their decisions and actions
 affect the environment, builds knowledge and skills necessary to address complex
 environmental issues, as well as ways we can take action to keep our environment
 healthy and sustainable for the future. It encourages character building, and develop
 positive attitudes and values.
- To develop the sense of awareness among the students about the environment and its
 various problems and to help the students in realizing the inter-relationship between
 man and environment and helps to protect the nature and natural resources.
- To help the students in acquiring the basic knowledge about environment and the social norms that provide unity with environmental characteristics and create positive attitude about the environment.

Our team visited Kumarakom, one of the beautiful ecosystems of Kerala. We spent time there with officials of Kumarakom, Panchayat. They explained various cultivation methods adopted by Kumarakom Paddy for improved sustainability of income generation. Though a large variety of vegetables are cultivated in the village, paddy fields cover almost half of the

total area. Rice cultivation here is laborious including many steps such as draining the fields and creating bunds. The village, like any other in Kuttanad, lies below sea-level and two crops are planted in a year – Viruppu (Kharif) cultivated between May and September and Punja (Rabi), cultivated between November and March. In Kumarakom, the rice is cultivated in blocks called padasekharams (polders). There 58 are about farmers' groups (padasekharasamithies) in Kuttanad. These samithies ensure joint sowing, dewatering, polder preparation and irrigation activities. Rice cultivation in Kumarakom, though economically viable, is not easy. There is a cycle of activities that begins with the removal of aquatic weeds from the rice fields. Another essential initial preparation is the construction or repair of outer bunds for the fields. As farming is done below the sea level, such bunds are necessary for dewatering.

Mixed crop cultivation is a thriving agricultural system in Kumarakom. In this type pf cultivation, a variety of crops are cultivated and livestock farming is also carried out. This integration reduces risks. Moreover, the output from one sector can be used in others. This kind of farming has resulted in increased production and improved sustainability of income generation.

OUTCOMES OF FIELD VISIT

 Helped students in acquiring the basic knowledge about environment and the social norms that provide unity with environmental characteristics and create positive attitude about the environment.

FIELD VISIT REPORT

INTRODUCTION

As per the curriculum of Mahatma Gandhi University, it was necessary for final year degree students to visit to a local area to document environmental grassland/ hill /mountain as a part of the course HUMAN RIGHTS AND MATHEMATICS FOR ENVIORNMENTAL STUDIES (MM5CRT05). Department of Mathematics, Baselius College planned, and organized such a field visit which helped the student to increase interest in environmental issues. The Visit was organized with prior permission and guidance of Dr. Biju Thomas, Principal (Baselius College) and Dr. Annie Cherian, HOD. The Final year B.Com. students of Baselius College participated in this visit. The 31 students and three staff members visited Kumarakom, one of the beautiful ecosystems of Kerala on 20th October 2022.

OBJECTIVES

- Environmental Education encourages students to research, investigate how and why things
 happen, and make their own decisions about complex environmental issues by developing and
 enhancing critical and creative thinking skills.
- Environmental Education helps students to understand how their decisions and actions affect the environment, builds knowledge and skills necessary to address complex environmental issues, as well as ways we can take action to keep our environment healthy and sustainable for the future. It encourages character building, and develop positive attitudes and values.

- To develop the sense of awareness among the students about the environment and its various problems and to help the students in realizing the inter-relationship between man and environment and helps to protect the nature and natural resources.
- To help the students in acquiring the basic knowledge about environment and the social norms
 that provide unity with environmental characteristics and create positive attitude about the
 environment.

Our team visited Kumarakom,one of the beautiful ecosystems of Kerala. We spent time there with officials of Kumarakom,Panchayat. They explained various cultivation methods adopted by Kumarakom Paddy for improved sustainability of income generation. Though a large variety of vegetables are cultivated in the village, paddy fields cover almost half of the total area. Rice cultivation here is laborious including many steps such as draining the fields and creating bunds. The village, like any other in Kuttanad, lies below sea-level and two crops are planted in a year — Viruppu (Kharif) cultivated between May and September and Punja (Rabi), cultivated between November and March. In Kumarakom, the rice is cultivated in blocks called padasekharams (polders). There are about 58 farmers' groups (padasekhara samithies) in Kuttanad. These samithies ensure joint sowing, dewatering, polder preparation and irrigation activities. Rice cultivation in Kumarakom, though economically viable, is not easy. There is a cycle of activities that begins with the removal of aquatic weeds from the rice fields. Another essential initial preparation is the construction or repair of outer bunds for the fields. As farming is done below the sea level, such bunds are necessary for dewatering.

Mixed crop cultivation is a thriving agricultural system in Kumarakom. In this type pf cultivation, a variety of crops are cultivated and livestock farming is also carried out. This integration reduces risks. Moreover, the output from one sector can be used in others. This kind of farming has resulted in increased production and improved sustainability of income generation.
