## Extension Activities

### Extension Activities of NSS

#### 1. Sneha Veedu

“Snehaveedu” was an ambitious project of Baselius College NSS unit. Volunteers took sincere efforts for raising the required fund. Students, teachers and all the staff of the college cooperated to the cause. Teaching, non-teaching staff, alumni and students remarkably contributed to this venture. All volunteers and programme officers worked hard on holidays including even days of lockout for the completion of the task. Students carried the construction materials such as bricks, cement, metal, septic tank, plumbing materials etc. from the road to the construction site which is several meters far from the road. On 8<sup>th</sup> April 2022, Vice Principal Dr. Jyothimol P. handed over the key of the house to the family. About 60 students have participated in the task.



## 2. School Cleaning

Taking care of yourself also means taking care of your environment. Cleaning and organizing is a practice not a project. As part school re-opening, the NSS Unit of Baselius College, Kottayam organized a cleaning session at Govt.U.P. School, Manarcadu. 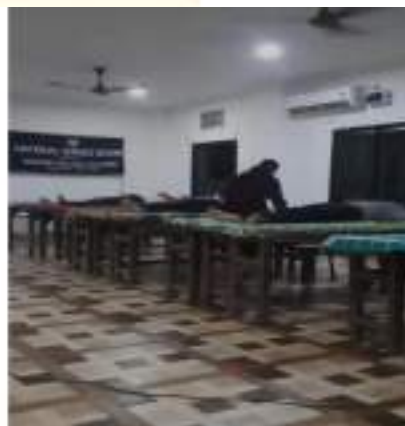

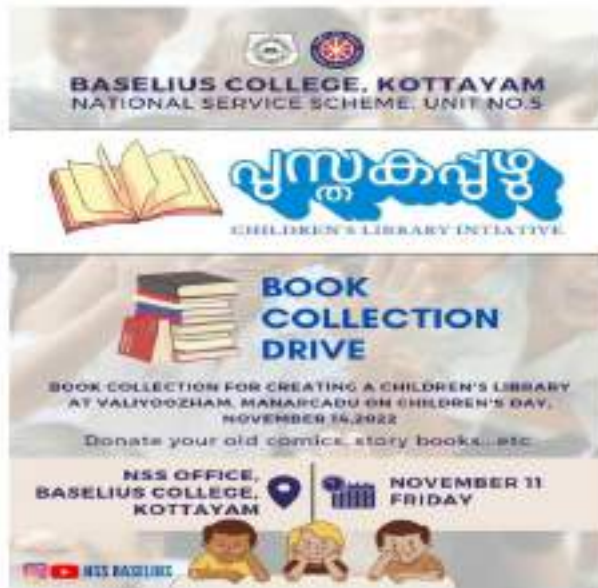

## 18. Pustaka Puzhu (Book Worm)

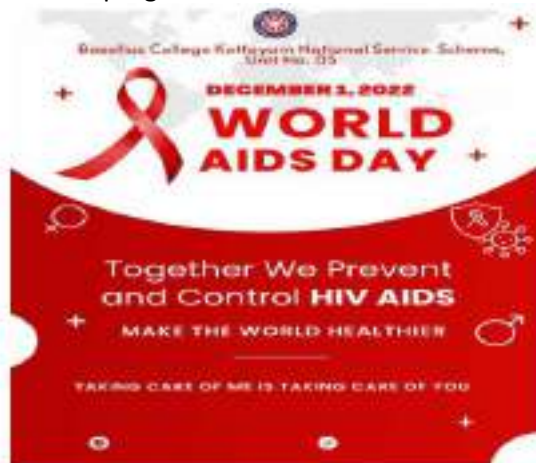

Febby Leo Mathew for the people with disability in Thiruvappu Grama Panchayat, an IP-Checklist was administered for the individualised plan for CBIDRMC to elicit and record information on the functioning and the disability of an individual for the development of IP-DRMC. The process of it included conducting a survey, cross checking of the information collected through the survey, focus group discussion to know the problems and necessities of the disabled people at times of disasters and recording the information collected as a checklist that is prepared based on ICF Checklist version 12A. On 16<sup>th</sup> February 2023, Adv. Febby Leo Mathew, Panchayat President, Mr Ajayan K Menon, Ward Member, Mr Sumesh Kanjiram gave felicitation speeches. Volunteers gathered for the same at SNDP Higher Secondary School Kanjiram. The volunteers took part in the cross checking of the information of the disabled persons collected through the survey and filling the checklist for each PWD via a Google form. A total of 34 beneficiaries were there.

## Extension Activities by NCC

### 30. Swachh Bharat Pakhwada

Swachhata Pakhwada was started in April 2016, with the objective of bringing a fortnight of intense focus on issues and practices of the Swachhata by engaging all the government ministries & departments in their jurisdictions. In order to plan the Pakhwada activities, an annual calendar is circulated among the Ministries in advanced. Ministries that observe Swachhata Pakhwada are monitored by means of online monitoring system of Swachhata Samiksha. On this system, action plans, images & videos related to Swachhata activities are uploaded and shared. Background This is an environment awareness campaign launched under Swachh Bharat Mission. It was launched to achieve the goal of total sanitizations and cleanliness by October 2, 2019. Under the campaign, several ministries organise a theme wise campaign called "Swachh Bharat Fortnight". It is a voluntary exercise, and it seeks to raise awareness and target programmes. Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM) SBM is a country-wide campaign that was initiated by central government in 2014 with the objective of eliminating open defecation and improving solid waste management. This mission is a restructured version of Nirmal Bharat Abhiyan which was launched in 2009. Nirmal Bharat Abhiyan failed to achieve its intended targets. Phase 1 of the Swachh Bharat mission ended in October 2019 while Phase 2 of the mission has been implemented between 2020–21 & 2024-25. On this day 10 cadets from our unit contributed to the campaign of Swachh Bharat Pakhwada conducted on 1st June 2022 at Arthunkal beach.



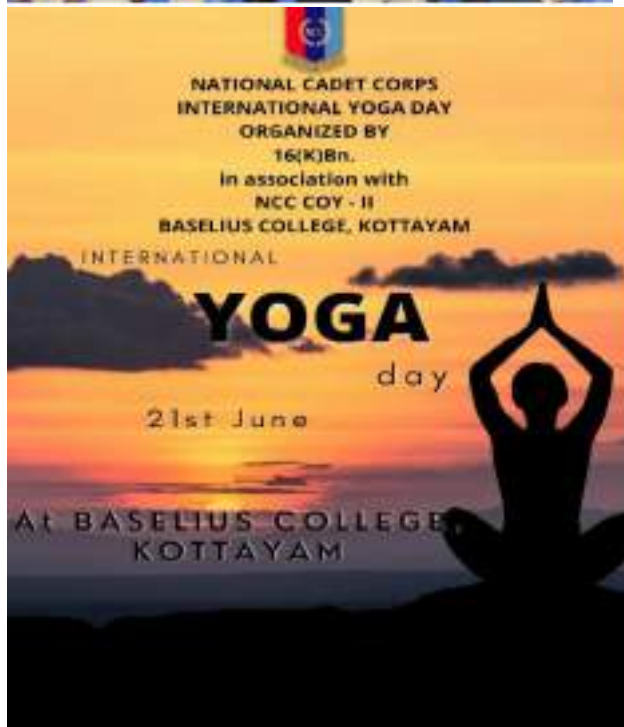
### 31. World Blood Donor Day

World Blood Donor Day takes place on 14 June each year. The Day was created to raise global awareness of the need for safe blood and blood products for transfusion, to highlight the critical contribution voluntary, unpaid blood donors make to national health systems, and to support national blood transfusion services, blood donor organizations, and other non-governmental organizations in strengthening and expanding their voluntary blood donor programmes by reinforcing national and local campaigns. The day also provides an opportunity to call to action governments and national health authorities to provide adequate resources to increase the collection of blood from voluntary, unpaid blood donors and to manage access to blood and the transfusion of those who require it.



### **32. International Yoga Day**

The 8<sup>th</sup> International Yoga Day was celebrated on 21<sup>st</sup> June 2022 at Baselius College organised by 16 (K) Battalion Kottayam in association with NCC Unit Coy-2 Baselius College Kottayam.
