
EXTENSION ACTIVITIES

Extension Activities of NSS

1. Sneha Veedu


3. Nalaikai Oru Thanal


11. "Karam Pidikkam Karakayattam"

17. Blood Donation Camp




18. Pustaka Puzhu (Book Worm)

The process of it included conducting a survey, cross checking of the information collected through the survey, focus group discussion to know the problems and necessities of the disabled people at times of disasters and recording the information collected as a checklist that is prepared based on ICF Checklist version 12A. 
28. Punjiricheppu

Extension Activities by NCC

30. Swachh Bharat Pakhwada

Swachhta Pakhwada was started in April 2016, with the objective of bringing a fortnight of intense focus on issues and practices of the Swachhta by engaging all the government ministries & departments in their jurisdictions. In order to plan the Pakhwada activities, an annual calendar is circulated among the Ministries in advanced. Ministries that observe Swachhata Pakhwada are monitored by means of online monitoring system of Swachhata Samiksha. On this system, action plans, images & videos related to Swachhata activities are uploaded and shared. Background This is an environment awareness campaign launched under Swachh Bharat Mission. It was launched to achieve the goal of total sanitizations and cleanliness by October 2, 2019. Under the campaign, several ministries organise a theme wise campaign called "Swachh Bharat Fortnight". It is a voluntary exercise, and it seeks to raise awareness and target programmes. Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM) SBM is a country-wide campaign that was initiated by central government in 2014 with the objective of eliminating open defecation and improving solid waste management. This mission is a restructured version of Nirmal Bharat Abhiyan which was launched in 2009. Nirmal Bharat Abhiyan failed to achieve its intended targets. Phase 1 of the Swachh Bharat mission ended in October 2019 while Phase 2 of the mission has been implemented between 2020–21 & 2024-25. On this day 10 cadets from our unit contributed to the campaign of Swachh Bharat Pakhwada conducted on 1st June 2022 at Arthunkal beach.






31. World Blood Donor Day

World Blood Donor Day takes place on 14 June each year. The Day was created to raise global awareness of the need for safe blood and blood products for transfusion, to highlight the critical contribution voluntary, unpaid blood donors make to national health systems, and to support national blood transfusion services, blood donor organizations, and other non-governmental organizations in strengthening and expanding their voluntary blood donor programmes by reinforcing national and local campaigns. The day also provides an opportunity to call to action governments and national health authorities to provide adequate resources to increase the collection of blood from voluntary, unpaid blood donors and to manage access to blood and the transfusion of those who require it.

32. International Yoga Day








33. International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking
