








3. A Talk on Knowledge Economy









4. Higher Education and Employment Opportunities

5. Career orientation class




6. Career Awareness class for CMA on 14/10/2022

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






8. Orientation programme for being a successful Chartered Accountant on 14/10/2022








9. Career as a Company Secretary on 20/10/2022








10. Career orientation Programme (Maths Dept)








11. "How to become a successful Chartered Accountant?" on 20/01/2023








12. Career Awareness Class on opportunities abroad on 20/02/2023

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
15 Career Awareness Class on opportunities abroad on 02/03/2023














16 Career Portraying for Future
