




4. Essay Writing Competition – INTRA


6. Inter Departmental Digital Poster Making

7. Business Quiz



8. Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav Competitions




9. Prof. M.J. Thomas Memorial Inter-Collegiate Quiz Competition


13. Power Quiz 2022- Quiz Club


17. Poster Designing Competition


20. <u>Inter- Collegiate Project Presentation Competition</u> <u>In Mathematical Science</u>




23. <u>Eunoia 2023</u>
