




4) Hands on training in scientific computing using Microsoft Excel




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
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7) International Yoga Day

10) Soft skill development and value education






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13) POSTER DESIGNING WORKSHOP – CANVA SOFTWARE







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15) From a volunteer to a leader


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20) Ayurveda for one health






21) SnapSlice Studio






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24) Design Discovery: Introduction to Poster Art with Canva




25) Robotics




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31) Work readiness program


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33) ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION
