7.1.4 Water Management & Conservation Facilities

The college has a very efficient system and procedure for the use and conservation of

water. The following facilities are available on the campus.

- There are three Rain water harvesting units with the capacity of 20000L,
 15000 L and 50000 L respectively.
- Open well recharge is followed on the campus. Rainwater from rooftops is channelized to a filter and it is allowed to flow into the well near Chemistry Department.
- Borewells are available in the college hostel.
- Tanks are constructed to collect municipal water. There are underground tanks for the same. There is a well in the college ground. Sufficient number of water tanks are constructed above each of the main buildings and both the hostels.
- Water bodies and distribution system are properly maintained on the Campus. The entire system of water distribution to various floors of all buildings, other points like Toilets, and re-arrangement of flow in case of emergencies are all properly planned and executed. In-house staff take care of the distribution.




