










PROF. VIJEESH VIJAYAN MEMORIAL LECTURE- SECOND EDITION

Outcomes:


It helped students to look beyond their textual knowledge and establish a relationship between theory and application of the learnt concepts.










DR AP MANI MEMORIAL INTER COLLEGIATE OUIZ 2023-24


