



The Curriculum committee evaluated the feedbacks from various stakeholders and took the following decisions:

- Based on feedback of PG students, it was decided to explore the possibility of providing more experiential learning opportunities. However, the Covid restrictions pose an issue for field trips, visits etc.
- Outcome attainments were to be monitored. This will help to identify the areas of strengths and weaknesses.
- Students shall be given awareness regarding online courses provided in the platforms like SWAYAM, NPTEL etc. and be motivated to take up such courses. .
- Blended learning shall be encouraged.
- Conduct sessions on entrepreneurship, startups, innovations, IPR etc.
- As the University is likely to undertake syllabus revision in the coming year, teachers shall gather all suggestions from the stakeholder group and present the same in the Syllabus Revision Workshops.
